DECLARATION OF DOUGLAS A. CAVANAGH

I, Douglas A. Cavanagh, hereby declare:

1. I am Vice-President of Research and Engineering of Pilot Chemical Holdings, Inc. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth below and if called upon to testify, I could and would testify competently as to the matters set forth herein.

2. **Pilot Chemical Company, a California corporation** filed and obtained federal trademark registrations as listed on Attachment 1 between August 27, 1963 and May 1, 1990.

3. On July 11, 2000 an assignment was executed transferring ownership of said trademarks from **Pilot Chemical Corp., a Delaware corporation** to **Pilot Chemical Holdings, Inc., a Delaware corporation**. This assignment was recorded at reel 2117, frame 0614 on July 13, 2000.

4. On July 14, 2004 we filed a Combined Sections 8 & 9 Declaration/Application in the name of **Pilot Chemical Company** for the ARISTOL trademark.

5. On September 10, 2004 the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office mailed a Post-Registration Office Action requesting clarification of the unexplained break in the chain of title.


6. On February 3, 2005 an assignment was executed transferring ownership of said trademarks from **Pilot Chemical Company, a California corporation** to **Pilot Chemical Corp., a Delaware corporation** to complete the chain of title for the marks. This assignment was recorded at reel 3049, frame 0472 on February 25, 2005. This assignment should properly have been recorded as a Nunc Pro Tunc assignment.

7. Although the execution date of the assignment mentioned in item 6 is after the July 11, 2000 assignment, I confirm that the actual transfer of ownership from **Pilot Chemical Company, a California corporation** to **Pilot Chemical Corp., a Delaware corporation** occurred prior to July 11, 2000, as a result of entity and structural changes within the company.

8. This declaration is attached to the corrective assignment to record the assignment mentioned in item 6 as a Nunc Pro Tunc assignment effective July 10, 2000.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California and the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct.
