ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARKS

1. Assignor hereby transfers and assigns unto Assignee all right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Trademarks and any and all registrations thereof.

2. Assignor hereby covenants to and with Assignee that Assignor (i) has good and marketable title in and to the Trademarks transferred, assigned and conveyed hereunder, subject to no liens, claims, encumbrances or restrictions of any kind, and (ii) has the right, power and authority to, and hereby does, assign, transfer and convey the Trademarks free and clear of all liens, claims, encumbrances and restrictions. Assignor hereby covenants that it will warrant and defend the same against all lawful claims whatsoever.

3. From time to time after the date hereof, Assignor agrees to execute all further documents and to take all necessary actions to effect the assignment, transfer and conveyance of all rights in and to the Trademarks to Assignee.

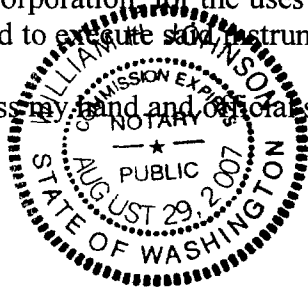
