COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

A regular meeting of the City of Marshfield Utility Commission was called to order by President Ken Krahn at 4:00 pm on February 14, 2005 in the upstairs meeting room of the utility office. Present were Commissioners Ken Krahn, Nelson Moffat, Dennis Martinson, Russ Wenzel, and Harry Nienaber. Also present were attorney Carl Meissner and the utility staff. Absent were Alderpersons Tim Kraus and Alanna Feddick.

UC/05-08 Motion by Martinson, seconded by Nienaber, to dispense with reading the minutes of the previous meetings and accept them as submitted. All ayes, motion carried.

UC/05-09 Motion by Nienaber, seconded by Martinson, to approve payroll for January in the amount of \$157,338.66 and general bills for January in the amount of \$2,146,734.92. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried.

UC/05-12 Motion by Moffat, seconded by Nienaber, to approve the purchase of a Water Department construction truck - Ford F550 \$31,991, Crane body, shelving, etc. \$66,252, Total \$98,243 from V & H Inc. All ayes, motion carried.

UC/05-13 Motion by Wenzel, seconded by Nienaber, to go into closed session per Wisconsin State Statutes 19.85(1)(c) considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility for the purpose of discussing labor negotiations, supervisory salary guidelines, and merit review of Assistant Office Manager and Electric Engineering Technician.

Closed session per Wisconsin State Statutes 19.85(1)(e) deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session for the purpose of discussing power supply negotiations and purchase of real estate for water supply.

UC/05-15 Motion by Nienaber, seconded by Moffat, to increase the annual salary of the Assistant Office Manager, Kent Mueller, from \$47,584 to \$49,107 effective 1/20/2005, and the Electrical Engineering Technician, Derrek Caflisch, from \$42,694 to \$44,743 effective 2/7/2005. All Ayes, motion carried.
