DEED OF TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

This Deed of Trademark Assignment ("Agreement"), effective as of the December 15, 2005 (the "Effective Date"), is from **UNIROYAL CHEMICAL COMPANY, INC.**, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware ("Assignor") to **CHEMTURA CORPORATION**, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of all right, title and interest in and to United States Trademark Registration No. 2,512,973 for the mark **FLORAMITE** (the "Trademark").

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to the Trademark, and the goodwill of the business with which the Trademark is used and which is symbolized by the Trademark.


NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged:

1. Assignment. Assignor hereby assigns and transfers unto Assignee, its successors, heirs and assigns, all right, title and interest in and to the Trademark, including without limitation, the right to any registration thereof, the right to prosecute any application therefor, the right to have any registration issue in the name of the Assignee, the right to apply for and obtain any renewal of any registration thereof, the right to sue for past and future infringement and the right to the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby.
2. Further Assurances. Assignor will execute any and all additional documents that may be reasonably necessary for Assignee to perfect the transfer of rights set forth herein.
3. Binding Provisions. This Agreement is binding upon, and inures to the benefit of, the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, legal representatives, successors, and permitted assigns.
4. Governing Law. All questions concerning the construction, validity and interpretation of this Agreement and the performance of the obligations imposed by this Agreement shall be governed by the internal law, not the law of conflicts, of the State of Connecticut.




