- 1. That they are the President and the Assistant Secretary, respectively, of Electro-Test, Inc., a California corporation.
- 2. That an amendment to the articles of incorporation of this corporation has been approved by the board of directors.
- 3. The amendment so approved by the board of directors is as follows:

Article 1 of the articles of incorporation of this corporation is amended to read as follows:

"1. The name of this corporation is Electrical Reliability Services, Inc."

4. That the shareholders have adopted said amendment by written consent. That the wording of said amendment as approved by written consent of the shareholders is the same as that set forth above.
