I, Barry A. Brandt, declare:

1. That I am the President of Hamilton Precision Metals of Delaware, Inc., and that I am authorized to execute this Declaration on its behalf;
2. That I am also the President of HP Acquisition Corp., the parent company of both Hamilton Precision Metals of Delaware, Inc. and Hamilton Precision Metals, Inc., and that I have been President of these companies since their inception in 2002.
3. That Hamilton Precision Metals of Delaware, Inc. is the owner of Registration Nos. 2,999,434; 2,307,266; and 2,277,917 for the marks HPM (stylized), HPM, and HAVAR;
4. That the chain of title as it appears in the records of the Assignment Branch of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office for the aforementioned registrations indicates that there is a break in the title chain between Hamilton Precision Metals, Inc., a Delaware corporation, and Hamilton Precision Metals, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership;
5. That the Hamilton Precision Metals, Inc. referred to in Paragraph 4 herein was a subsidiary of Katy Industries Inc., and is not the Hamilton Precision Metals, Inc. referred to in Paragraph 2 herein;
6. That, based on information and belief, Hamilton Precision Metals, Inc., a Delaware corporation, assigned its entire right, title and interest, together with all of the associated goodwill, in the registered marks to Hamilton Precision Metals, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership, in the late 2001/early 2002 time frame;
7. That, based on information and belief, the aforementioned registrations were assigned from Hamilton Precision Metals, Inc. to Hamilton Precision Metals, L.P. as a result of a corporate restructuring by Katy Industries Inc.;
8. That, based on information and belief, the documentation formally assigning the aforementioned registrations either does not exist or cannot be located, due to changes in personnel;

9. That the facts set forth in this Declaration are true; that all statements made herein of our own knowledge are true; and that all statements made herein on information and belief are believed to be true; that these statements are made with the knowledge that willful false statements and the like so made are punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under 18 U.S.C. 1001, and that such willful false statements may jeopardize the validity of the application or document or any registration resulting therefrom.
