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## INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT

This Intellectual Property Security Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into as of June 27, 2007, by and between INVESTEC ADMINISTRATIVE AGENT (UK) LTD. ("Administrative Agent") and SONIM TECHNOLOGIES, INC. ("Grantor").

### RECITALS

WHEREAS, Grantor has entered into the Loan and Security Agreement, dated as of the date hereof, with Administrative Agent and the Lenders named therein (as the same may be amended, modified or supplemented from time to time, the "Loan Agreement"; capitalized terms used herein without definition shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Loan Agreement), pursuant to which Grantor has granted Administrative Agent, as collateral agent for the Lenders, a security interest in Grantor's personal property assets to secure payment and performance of the Obligations;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound, as collateral security for the prompt and complete payment when due of its Obligations, Grantor hereby represents, warrants, covenants and agrees as follows:

### AGREEMENT

1. Grant of Security Interest. To secure its Obligations, Grantor grants and pledges to Administrative Agent, as collateral agent for the Lenders, a security interest in all of Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under its Intellectual Property Collateral (including without limitation those copyrights, patents, trademarks and mask works listed on Exhibits A, B, C, and D hereto), and including, without limitation, all proceeds thereof (such as, by way of example but not by way of limitation, license royalties and proceeds of infringement suits), the right to sue for past, present and future infringements, all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world and all re-issues, divisions continuations, renewals, extensions and continuations-in-part thereof.

This security interest is granted in conjunction with the security interest granted to Administrative Agent under the Loan Agreement. The rights and remedies of Administrative Agent with respect to the security interest granted hereby are in addition to those set forth in the Loan Agreement and the other Financing Documents, and those which are now or hereafter available to Administrative Agent as a matter of law or equity. Each right, power and remedy of Administrative Agent provided for herein or in the Loan Agreement or any of the other Financing Documents, or now or hereafter existing at law or in equity shall be cumulative and concurrent and shall be in addition to every right, power or remedy provided for herein and the exercise by Administrative Agent of any one or more of the rights, powers or remedies provided for in this Intellectual Property Security Agreement, the Loan Agreement or any of the other Financing Documents, or now or hereafter existing at law or in equity, shall not preclude the simultaneous or later exercise by any person, including Administrative Agent, of any or all other rights, powers or remedies.

2. Covenants. Grantor shall deliver to Administrative Agent, concurrent with its delivery of each Compliance Certificate pursuant to the Loan Agreement, a report signed by Grantor, in form reasonably acceptable to Administrative Agent, listing all applications and registrations that Grantor has made or filed in respect of any copyrights, patents, trademarks and mask works and the status of all outstanding applications or registrations. Grantor shall promptly advise Administrative Agent of any material change in the composition of the Collateral hereunder, including, but not limited to, any subsequent ownership right of the Grantor in or to any copyright, patent, trademark or mask work not specified in this Agreement;

3. Further Assurances; Attorney in Fact.

(a) On a continuing basis, Grantor will make, execute, acknowledge and deliver, and file and record in the proper filing and recording places in the United States, all such instruments, including appropriate financing and continuation statements and collateral agreements and filings with the United States Patent and Trademark Office and the Register of Copyrights, and take all such action as may reasonably be deemed necessary or advisable, or as reasonably requested by Administrative Agent, to perfect Administrative Agent's security interest in all copyrights, patents, trademarks and mask works and otherwise to carry out the intent and purposes of this Agreement, or for assuring and confirming to Administrative Agent the grant or perfection of a security interest in all Collateral hereunder.

(b) Grantor hereby irrevocably appoints Administrative Agent as Grantor's attorney-in-fact, with full authority in the place and stead of Grantor and in the name of Grantor, from time to time in Administrative Agent's discretion, to take any action and to execute any instrument which Administrative Agent may deem necessary or advisable to accomplish the purposes of this Agreement, including (i) to modify, in its reasonable discretion, this Agreement without first obtaining Grantor's approval of or signature to such modification by amending Exhibits "A," "B", "C," and "D" hereof, as appropriate, to include reference to any right, title or interest in any copyrights, patents, trademarks or mask works acquired by Grantor after the execution hereof or to delete any reference to any right, title or interest in any copyrights, patents, trademarks or mask works in which Grantor no longer has or claims any right, title or interest, (ii) to file, in its reasonable discretion, one or more financing or continuation statements and amendments thereto, relative to any of such Collateral without the signature of Grantor where permitted by law, and (iii) after the occurrence and during the continuance of an Event of Default, to transfer the Collateral into the name of Administrative Agent or a third party to the extent permitted under the New York Uniform Commercial Code.

4. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by, and shall be construed and enforced in accordance with, the laws of the State of New York, without regard to conflicts of law principles.

5. Amendments. This Agreement may be amended only by a written instrument signed by both parties hereto, except for amendments permitted under Section 3 hereof to be made by Administrative Agent alone.

6. Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which together shall constitute the same instrument.
