NULLIFICATION OF TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

This Nullification Of Trademark Assignment ("Nullification") is made by and between Orthovita, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation with a place of business at 77 Great Valley Parkway, Malvern, Pennsylvania 19355, and Vita Special Purpose Corp. II, a Delaware corporation with a place of business at 77 Great Valley Parkway, Malvern, Pennsylvania 19355.

WHEREAS, Vita Special Purpose Corp. (as distinguished from Vita Special Purpose Corp. II), formerly a Delaware corporation with a place of business at 77 Great Valley Parkway, Malvern, Pennsylvania 19355, was merged with and into Vita Licensing, Inc. on September 26, 2007, via a document titled "Certificate of Ownership and Merger Merging Vita Special Purpose Corp. into Vita Licensing, Inc."; and

WHEREAS, Vita Licensing, Inc., formerly a Delaware corporation with a place of business at 300 Delaware Avenue, Suite 900, Wilmington, Delaware 19801, was merged with and into Orthovita, Inc. on September 28, 2007, via a document titled "Certificate of Ownership and Merger Merging Partisyn Corp. and Vita Licensing, Inc. into Orthovita, Inc." filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Delaware, and a document titled "Articles/Certificate of Merger" filed with the Pennsylvania Department of State; and

WHEREAS, Vita Special Purpose Corp. and Vita Special Purpose Corp. II were parties to a Trademark Assignment executed on September 10, 2007, and recorded

Registration No. 2,646,320

with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office at Frame 0555 of Reel 3618 on September 11, 2007 ("the Trademark Assignment"), directed to U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,646,320 for the mark **CORTOSS** (hereinafter "the Mark"); and


WHEREAS, it is the intent of the parties that this Nullification nullify in its entirety, revoke, surrender, and otherwise render invalid, void *ab initio*, and of no force or effect the Trademark Assignment; and

WHEREAS, Vita Special Purpose Corp. II warrants and represents that it has not encumbered U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,646,320 or the Mark via lien, security interest, license, assignment, mortgage, transfer, or otherwise; and

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereby nullify in its entirety, revoke, surrender, and otherwise render invalid, void *ab initio*, and of no force or effect the Trademark Assignment. As a consequence, Orthovita, Inc. owns all right, title, and interest in and to U.S. Trademark Registration No. 2,646,320 and the Mark, together with the good will of the business symbolized by the Mark, and the right to sue and recover damages for past infringements thereof.


