APPOINTMENT OF AGENT BY UC
FOR INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY REASSIGNMENTS FROM UC TO
LAWRENCE LIVERMORE NATIONAL SECURITY, LLC

THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA (hereinafter referred to as the “University”) have signed a Supplemental Agreement (Modification No. M534) to Contract W-7405-ENG-48 wherein Modification No. M534, *Section I.081 (i) Transfer to Successor Contractor* addresses transfer and/or assignment of matters including Intellectual Property from the University to the successor contractor Lawrence Livermore National Security, LLC (LLNS) at the earliest appropriate time.

Modification No. M534, *Section I.081 (b) Definitions* sets out that the Intellectual Property includes all forms of “intellectual property” whatsoever, including but not limited to patents, trademarks, copyrights, mask works, protected CRADA information, and other forms of comparable property rights protected by Federal Law and other foreign counterparts.

Intellectual Property under Contract W-7405-ENG-48 may require an assignment at a future date from named inventors to the University, where the University was their employer at the time of invention for inventions described and/or disclosed in pending or subsequently submitted invention disclosures.

Under Modification No. M534 to contract W-7405-ENG-48, any such future assignments to the University must be transferred to the successor contractor at the earliest appropriate time.

Accordingly, the University hereby appoints the following person, John H. Lee, as Agent for the specific and limited purpose of submitting a reassignment from the University to LLNS, the successor contractor, of any subsequent Intellectual Property identified as arising under Contract W-7405-ENG-48 for recordation in the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) and corresponding foreign IP offices. Such reassignment shall preferably be filed with the USPTO and corresponding IP offices for recordation at the same time an initial assignment from named inventors to the University is filed with the USPTO for recordation thereby transferring assignment at the earliest appropriate time. Additionally, the Agent may sign foreign IP office related documents on behalf of the University for up to one year from the date of this document, such documents including but not limited to powers of attorney as may be required by foreign IP offices.
