Victoria and Richard MacKenzie-Childs, Ltd. ("VRMC") and MacKenzie-Childs of New York, Ltd. ("MC New York") (collectively, the "Debtors"), by and through their attorneys, Hancock & Estabrook, LLP, having moved before this Court for an Order: (a) pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 363(b) and (f) and Bankruptcy Rule 6004 approving the sale of

substantially all of the Debtors' assets which include personal property consisting of the Debtors' inventory, equipment, machinery, furnishings, accounts receivable, intellectual property, licenses, supplies, livestock and contract rights, and VRMC's real property consisting of approximately 70 acres of land improved by various buildings, (collectively, the "Assets"), outside the ordinary course of business, free and clear of liens, claims and encumbrances pursuant to the terms of an Asset Purchase Agreement, as modified; and (b) authorizing MC New York to assume and assign its interest in one (1) lease of non-residential real property, free and clear of all liens, claim and encumbrances pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 365(a), (f) and (k) and 11 U.S.C. §§ 363(b) and (f) and Bankruptcy Rules 6004 and 6006; and the Court having approved the format of an auction sale and certain bid procedures by Order Establishing Bid Procedures for Sale of Debtors' Assets dated May 18, 2001 ("Bid Procedures Order"); and the Debtors having provided Notice of the auction sale and proposed assumption and assignment to all prospective bidders, creditors and parties in interest, including the Office of the United States Trustee, in accordance with the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; and due proof of service thereof having been filed with this Court;

NOW, upon reading and filing the Notice of Debtors' Omnibus Motion for Orders: (i) Authorizing Sale of Substantially All of Debtors' Assets Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 363(b)(1) and (f), Free and Clear of Liens and Encumbrances, Outside the Ordinary Course of Business; (ii) Approving the Assumption and Assignment of a Certain Lease Agreement Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 365(b), (f) and (k); and (iii) Approving Break-Up Fee and Establishing Procedures for Sale of Assets Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 105(a) dated April 26, 2001 and the Debtors' Omnibus Motion for Orders: (i) Authorizing Sale of Substantially All of Debtors' Assets

Woodard, Esq., sworn to the 15th day of May, 2001 in opposition to the relief requested; and pursuant to the Motion and the Bid Procedures Order, an auction sale concerning the Assets having been conducted before this Court at the United States Courthouse in Utica, New York on May 21, 2001; and the Debtors having appeared by Hancock & Estabrook, LLP (Stephen A. Donato, Esq. and Camille W. Hill, Esq., of counsel) in support of the relief requested; and appearances having been entered on behalf of BSB Bank & Trust Company by Menter, Rudin & Trivelpiece, P.C. (Jeffrey A. Dove, Esq., of counsel), Victoria and Richard MacKenzie-Childs by Martin, Martin & Woodard, LLP (Lee E. Van Baalen, Esq.; and this Court having heard sufficient reason why the Assets should be sold pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 363(f); and MCL Acquisition Corporation and MCNY Acquisition Corporation (collectively, the "Buyers") having submitted the highest and best bid for the Assets as accepted by the Debtors; and no party having submitted a higher or better offer for the Assets; and it appearing that the sale of the Assets is in the best interests of the Debtors' estates; and all objections to the relief requested having been resolved or ruled upon; and due deliberation having been had thereon, and good cause appearing therefor; it is hereby

**ORDERED**, that except as otherwise provided in this Order, the Debtors' auction sale of the Assets, outside the ordinary course of business, free and clear of all liens, claims and encumbrances, is a reasonable exercise of the Debtors' business judgment and such judgment is hereby approved and confirmed; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that sufficient cause exists to warrant the sale of the Assets, which consist of substantially all of the Debtors' assets, outside a plan of reorganization, and such sale is in the best interests of the Debtors, their respective estates and their creditors and it is hereby approved and confirmed in its entirety; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that proper, timely, adequate and sufficient notice of the auction sale was provided to all parties in interest, prospective bidders and the Office of the United States Trustee in accordance with Bankruptcy Rules 2002(a)(2), 6004 and 9014; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that no other or further notice of the auction sale is necessary; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Buyers shall be deemed the successor to BSB Bank & Trust Company (the "Lender") ("Lender" shall also refer to Buyers as successors to Lender), Lender's claims in the Debtors' Chapter 11 cases and Lender's interest in the Cash Collateral Stipulation dated January 5, 2001 (the "Cash Collateral Stipulation") and approved by this Court pursuant to a Final Order Approving Debtor's Use of Cash Collateral and Providing Adequate Protection dated January 19, 2001 and thereafter extended by various Orders in the Debtors' Chapter 11 cases (the "Cash Collateral Order"); and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Buyers have submitted the highest and best offer for the Assets and are purchasers acting in good faith, as that term is utilized in the Title 11 of the United States Code, and are not insiders, as that term is defined in 11 U.S.C. § 101; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the terms and conditions of the bid submitted by the Buyers be, and the same hereby are, approved in all respects; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the bid of the Buyers for the Assets, free and clear of all liens, claims and encumbrances, is hereby approved in all respects; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the provisions of 11 U.S.C. §§ 363(b) and (f) have been complied with as to the auction sale; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Debtors are authorized and empowered to sell, transfer, assign and convey the Assets, free and clear of all liens, claims and encumbrances, pursuant to the Asset Purchase Agreement dated April 26, 2001, as amended on May 21, 2001, to the Buyers for a purchase price of \_\_\_\_\_ (as set forth below), plus \_\_\_\_\_ in the form of a credit bid of the indebtedness of the Debtors purchased by the Buyers from Lender, plus the

ORDERED, that upon the closing of the sale of the Assets, the Buyers shall take title to and possession of the Assets, including the Madison Avenue Lease, free and clear of (a) any mortgages, security interests, liens or encumbrances of any kind, (b) any demands or claims of creditors of, or claimants against, the Debtors, (c) any interests of shareholders or other interests in the Debtors, (d) any person claiming through, by or on behalf of the Debtors, whether such claim, demand, lien, or interest be direct or indirect, known or unknown, or claiming that the successful bidder is a successor, successor-in-interest or pursuant to any other theory, and (e) all environmental, warranty and product liability claims that may be asserted against the Debtors, as to the Buyers; provided however, that the Buyers shall not be relieved of liability with respect to obligations accruing under the Assets or Madison Avenue Lease from and after the closing of the sale; and it is further

ORDERED, that no charging liens under 11 U.S.C. § 506(c) shall be asserted against the Lender's Collateral, nor shall any other lien be entered against the Collateral for any reason, including costs or expenses of administration of the bankruptcy estates, prior to or on a parity with: (i) claims of Lender arising out of the Loans, advances and extensions of credit which may be or have been made by Lender to the Debtors pursuant to the Cash Collateral Stipulation or pursuant to any agreement, instrument or document executed in furtherance of

the Cash Collateral Stipulation, or (ii) the security interests and liens of Lender upon the Collateral (capitalized terms in this paragraph are as defined in the Cash Collateral Order); and it is further

ORDERED, that the Buyers, as successors to the Lender, shall subordinate any unsecured deficiency claim they may assert to the claims of general, nonpriority unsecured creditors in the Debtors' cases; and it is further

ORDERED, that MC New York shall be deemed to have assumed the lease of non-residential real property entered into between MC New York and Judson Realty, LLC, as agent for Bicent Properties, for retail space located at 824 Madison Avenue, New York, New York (the "Madison Avenue Lease"), and shall assign the same to MCNY Acquisition Corporation under the terms of the Asset Purchase Agreement, as amended, free and clear of all liens, claims and encumbrances, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 363 and 365(a), (f) and (k), with the assumption and assignment conditioned upon the closing of the sale as contemplated under the Asset Purchase Agreement, as amended, and this Order, which assumption and assignment are in all respects approved; and it is further

ORDERED, that MC New York is further directed to pay, from the proceeds of sale, all amounts due as pre-petition and other cure amounts payable, if any, under the Madison Avenue Lease. MCNY Acquisition Corporation shall then have assumed the Madison Avenue Lease and, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 365(f), the assignment by MC New York of the Madison Avenue Lease shall not be a default thereunder, and the Madison Avenue Lease shall be deemed to be in full force and effect; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that immediately upon the assignment of the Madison Avenue Lease, as set forth above, MC New York and its estate shall be granted the protection afforded pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 365(k); and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Debtors' duly appointed officers are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute any and all deeds, bills of sale, assignments, releases or other instruments and papers necessary to effectuate the terms and conditions of the sale of the Assets, and the sale and assignment of the Madison Avenue Lease; and it is further



**ORDERED**, that the Buyers shall provide counsel for the Debtors with access to the Debtors' books and records and an individual knowledgeable of the Debtors' records and operations in order to assist counsel with the conduct of Article 5 actions, the claims review process and any other proceedings necessary to properly conclude the Debtors' Chapter 11 cases; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that this Order shall be binding upon, and inure to the benefit of, the Debtors, the lessor under the Madison Avenue Lease and the Buyers, and their respective assigns, including, without limitation, any trustee(s) hereafter appointed for the Debtors' estates; and it is further

ORDERED, that this Court shall and hereby does retain sole and exclusive jurisdiction to determine any dispute, issue or other matter arising under the Asset Purchase Agreement, as amended, or this Order.

## BILL OF SALE AND ASSIGNMENT

**BILL OF SALE and ASSIGNMENT**, dated as of June 8, 2001, from **VICTORIA AND RICHARD MACKENZIE-CHILDS, LTD.**, a New York corporation whose address is 3260 State Route 90, Aurora, New York 13026 (the "Seller") to **MCL ACQUISITION CORPORATION**, Delaware corporations whose address is c/o Vogel Consulting Group, S.C., 3415 Gateway Road, Brookfield, Wisconsin 53045 (the "Purchaser").

WHEREAS, by a certain Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of April 26, 2001, as amended by a First Amendment to Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of May 21, 2001, as approved by Order of the Bankruptcy Court dated June 8, 2001, by and among Seller and Purchaser (the "Asset Purchase Agreement"), Seller agreed to transfer, sell, convey, release, assign and deliver to Purchaser, and Purchaser agreed to purchase substantially all of the operating assets of Seller except the assets excluded pursuant to Section 1.2 of the Asset Purchase Agreement (such assets to be acquired sometimes being referred to as the "Assets");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Asset Purchase Agreement, Seller has made certain representations, warranties and covenants concerning various matters, including, but not limited to, the Assets, Seller's performance under the Asset Purchase Agreement, and the conduct of Seller's business ("Seller's Warranties");

WHEREAS, Seller is executing and delivering this Bill of Sale and Assignment to Purchaser for the purpose of transferring, selling, conveying, releasing, assigning and delivering to, and vesting in, Purchaser the Assets; and

WHEREAS, simultaneously, with such sale and pursuant to due authorization, Purchaser has paid the purchase price contemplated by Section 2.1 of the Asset Purchase Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the purchase price and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Seller by these presents does, except to the extent excluded herein or pursuant to Section 1.2 of the Asset Purchase Agreement, bargain and sell, transfer, convey, release, assign and deliver to, and vest in Purchaser all of the assets, properties and rights tangible and intangible, real, personal or mixed owned by Seller as of the date hereof wherever located, whether known or unknown and whether or not on the books of Seller and, to the extent assignable and in accordance with Section 1.1 of the Asset Purchase Agreement, all of Seller's rights under all agreements, contracts, licenses, leases, documents and other contracts to which Seller is a party as of the date hereof, including without limitation the following, as more particularly identified, in Schedule 1.1(f) of the Asset Purchase Agreement:

- (a) All inventories of whatever kind, including, without limitation, finished goods, work-in-process and raw materials, socks, and all packaging and shipping inventory (the "Inventories");
- (b) All trade and other accounts receivable, all notes receivable and all other amounts receivable (except receivables owing from MacKenzie-Childs of California, Ltd. and MacKenzie-Childs of Canada, Ltd.) (the "Receivables");
- (c) All current assets (not including cash and cash equivalents);
- (d) All prepaid expenses, advance payments and deposits (the "Prepaid Expenses");
- (e) All equipment (building or office), machinery, tooling, dies, molds, patterns, stampings, prototypes, parts, components, projects in process, furniture, antiques, artwork, fixtures, tools, related spare parts and supplies, manuals, written warranties or other similar documents related thereto and



fixed assets, including, without limitation, those items listed on Schedule L.1(e) attached hereto (the "Equipment");

- (f) All rights of the Seller pursuant to the contracts, agreements, leases and similar obligations listed on Schedule L.1(f) (the "Contracts");
- (g) All governmental and non-governmental licenses, permits, authorizations, certifications, accreditations, consents and indulgences;
- (h) All manufacturing, delivery, office and other supplies;
- (i) All Intellectual Property (including, without limitation, all Intellectual Property listed on Schedule L.1(i)) and all goodwill associated with the foregoing, all goodwill associated with respect thereto, licenses and sublicenses granted and obtained with respect thereto and rights thereunder, remedies against infringements thereof and rights to protection of interests therein under the laws of all jurisdictions;
- (j) All warranty rights, guaranty rights, causes of actions, judgments and claims and similar rights of the Seller against vendors, suppliers, designers, architects, engineers or other third parties;
- (k) All leasehold interest in real property;
- (l) All livestock, animals (including the young of all livestock and animals), crops, livestock feed, farm supplies and farm products;
- (m) All rights pursuant to the license agreement with Momeni, Inc., Paper Products designed U.S. Inc. (including, but not limited to, the Henny Penny Product/Design) and Dal-Tile Corporation;
- (n) All business and personnel records and documents of the Seller;
- (o) All unemployment compensation account balances;
- (p) All cash surrender value of life insurance owned by the Seller; and
- (q) All causes of action, choses in action and rights of recovery with respect to any of the foregoing.

All of the above, except as relating to the retail store owned and operated by MacKenzie-Childs of New York, Ltd.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all the Assets unto Purchaser, its successors and assigns, to its own use and benefit forever, and Seller does for itself, its successors and assigns, covenant and agree with Purchaser to WARRANT AND DEFEND the sale of the Assets against all and every person and person whomsoever.

**Section 1.** Seller hereby constitutes and appoints Purchaser, its successors and assigns, as the true and lawful attorney and attorney of Seller with full power of substitution in the name and stead of Seller, but on behalf and for the benefit of Purchaser, its successor and assigns, to demand and receive any and all of the assets, properties and rights assigned or to be assigned to Purchaser pursuant to the Asset Purchase Agreement and to give receipts and releases for and in respect to the same or any part thereof, to endorse any claim or right of any kind in respect thereof and to do all acts and things in relation to the above-mentioned assets, properties and rights which Purchaser, its successors or assigns may deem desirable, Seller hereby declaring that the foregoing powers are coupled with an interest and are not revocable and shall not be revoked by Seller for any reason whatsoever.

**Section 2.** Seller authorizes Purchaser, its successors and assigns to receive and open all mail, telegrams and other communications, and all express or other packages, addressed to Seller at its address set forth above and to retain the same insofar as they relate to the Assets, but any such mail, telegrams, communications or express or other packages (or copies thereof) not relating primarily to the Assets shall be forwarded forthwith to Seller at the address from time to time specified in writing by Seller for such purposes. The foregoing shall constitute full authorization to the postal authorities, all telegraph and express companies, and all other persons to make delivery of such items to Purchaser.

**Section 3.** Seller for itself, its successors and assigns hereby covenant and agree that, any time and from time to time forthwith upon the written request of Purchaser, Seller will, at Purchaser's expense, do, execute, acknowledge and deliver or cause to be done, executed, acknowledged or delivered, all and every such further acts, deeds, assignments and transfers reasonably required or requested by Purchaser in order to assign, transfer, set over, convey, release, assure and confirm unto, and vest in, Purchaser, its successors and assigns, or to aid and assist Purchaser in collecting or reducing to possession any or all of the Assets assigned or to be assigned to Purchaser.


