TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Assignor agrees to assign ownership of Assignor's trademark ROUGHTEX, U.S. Registration Number 1,467,360, ("Trademark") to Assignee under the terms of this Assignment; and

WHEREAS, Assignor is the sole and exclusive owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to Trademark, and the goodwill associated therewith; and

WHEREAS, Assignor wishes to assign to Assignee all right, title and interest in and to the Trademark, together with the goodwill associated therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor and Assignee, each intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

1. Assignor shall assign, transfer and set over to Assignee the entire right, title and interest in and to the Trademark together with the goodwill of the business in connection with which the Trademark is used for Assignee's own use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of Assignee successors, assigns or other legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the Assignor if this Assignment had not been made, together with all income, royalties or payments due or payable as of the date hereof or thereafter, including, without limitation, all claims for damages by reason of past, present or future infringement or other unauthorized use of the Trademark, with the right to sue for, and collect the same for Assignee's own use and enjoyment and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.

2. Assignee shall request the United States Patent and Trademark Office to record Assignee as owner of the Trademark, including any variations thereof, for the sole use and enjoyment of assignee, its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.

3. Assignor hereby represents and warrants that it owns all right, title and interest in and to the Trademark free and clear of any liens and encumbrances, that it has full right to assign all of its interests therein, and that it has not executed and will not execute any agreement or other instrument in conflict herewith.

4. This Assignment is binding on the Assignor and its respective successors and assigns, and inures to the benefit of the Assignee and its successors and assigns.

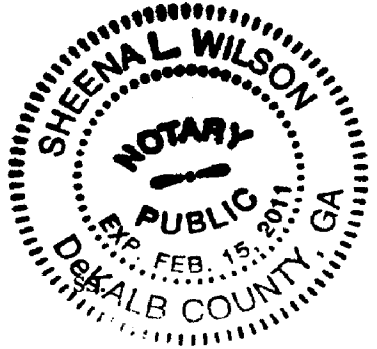

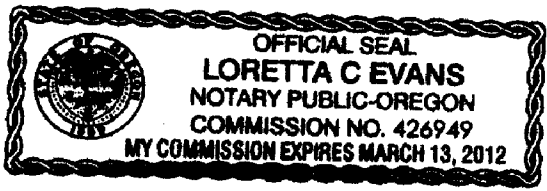
