2. Article First of the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation is amended to read as follows:

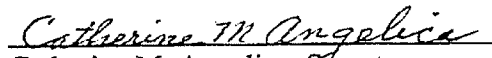
"The name of the corporation is LINEAR INDUSTRIES, LTD."
