ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARK

NOW, THEREFORE, for \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor does hereby quitclaim, assign, transfer, sell and convey unto Assignee (i) any and all right, title and interest in, to and under the Mark and all federal, state and common law rights therein, including any application and/or registrations thereof, (ii) the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Mark, and (iii) the right to recover damages for past infringement of the Mark.

Assignor agrees to execute all papers and to do all things necessary to ensure that Assignee acquires full right, title and interest in and to the Mark.
