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ASSIGNMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

THIS ASSIGNMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY is made this 3rd day of November 2006, by Afternic, Inc., a Florida corporation ("Assignor"), in favor of Domain MarketPlace, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Assignee"). All capitalized words and terms used in this Assumption Agreement and not defined herein shall have the respective meanings ascribed to them in the Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of the date hereof by and among Assignee, Assignor and the stockholders of Assignor signatories thereto (the "Agreement").

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, Assignor has agreed to sell, assign, transfer, convey and deliver to Assignee all of Assignor's rights, title and interest in, to and under the Purchased Assets; and

WHEREAS, certain of the Purchased Assets constitute Business Intellectual Property, which the parties desire to sell, assign, convey and transfer by this instrument.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor does hereby:

SELL, ASSIGN, CONVEY AND TRANSFER to Assignee all of its right, title and interest in and to: (i) the Business Intellectual Property, including all rights to use, exploit, license and otherwise dispose of the same; (ii) all divisional, continuing, substitute, renewal, reissue, extension, and all other applications which have been or shall be filed in the United States and all other countries in respect of the Business Intellectual Property or any improvements or derivatives thereof, specifically including the right to file such applications under the provisions of any convention or treaty and claim priority based on such application in the United States; (iii) all original, renewal, extension and reissued registrations which have been or shall be issued in the United States and all other countries in respect of the Business Intellectual Property of any improvements or derivatives thereof; (iv); all claims for damages for reason of past or current infringement of the Business Intellectual Property, as well as the right to sue for and collect the same for its own use and enjoyment; and (v) with respect to any and all trademarks, service marks or trade names, the goodwill of the business associated therewith and appurtenant thereto.

WITH RESPECT TO THE PURCHASED ASSETS CONSISTING OF COPYRIGHTS AND WORKS SUBJECT TO COPYRIGHT, WAIVE AND RELEASE any moral rights, including the rights of attribution or integrity Assignor may have in said work(s), including any moral rights arising under 17 U.S.C. §106A, other U.S. federal law, state law or laws of any foreign country for any and all applications in which either the right of attribution or the right of integrity may be implicated. The moral rights hereby waived include, but are not limited to: (1) any right to require Assignee or its successors or licensees to identify Assignor as the author of the work; and (2) the right to prevent destruction of, or any intentional distortion, mutilation, or other modification of, the work.

Assignment of Intellectual Property – Page 2

AUTHORIZE the Director of the United States Patent & Trademark Office, the United States Register of Copyrights, and/or any official of any U.S. state or states, or any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to record trademark registrations, applications and title thereto, to record the Business Intellectual Property and title thereto as the property of Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

COVENANT that, when requested and at the expense of Assignee, execute and deliver to Assignee any and all documents reasonably requested by Assignee to effectuate the assignment described herein,

COVENANT that this Assignment will be binding on the successors of Assignor and extend to the successors, assigns and nominees of Assignee.

This Assignment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.


This Assignment shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the law of the State of Florida, without regard to the conflicts of law rules of such state.

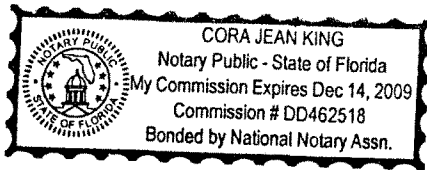
