24 The verified Second and Final Account and Report of Status of  
25 Administration of Executors and Petition for: (1) Settlement  
26 Thereof; (2) Payment of Remaining Statutory Executors' Commissions,  
27 (3) Payment of Extraordinary Executors' Commissions; (4) Payment  
28 Remaining Statutory Attorneys' Fees; (5) Payment of Extraordinary

1 Attorneys' Fees; (6) Reimbursement of Costs Advanced; (7) Filing  
2 Fee Refund and (8) Final Distribution to Trustees filed March 8,  
3 2007 by Larry J. Dressler, Avra Douglas and Morris M. Medavoy as  
4 Executors of the Estate of Marlon Brando (the "Petition") came on  
5 regularly for hearing on April 18, 2007, at 8:30 a.m., in  
6 Department 5 of this Court. From proof made to the satisfaction of  
7 the Court, the Court finds as follows:

8 1) Notice: Notice has been given as required by law.

9 2) Second and Final Account Approved: All of the acts and  
10 transactions of Petitioners, Larry J. Dressler, Avra Douglas and  
11 Morris M. Medavoy as Executors of the Estate of Marlon Brando,  
12 during the period of the Second and Final Account and Report are  
13 truly shown and should be settled, allowed and approved as filed,  
14 and all allegations of the Petition for its settlement and for  
15 final distribution are true.

16 3) Date of Death: Marlon Brando died testate on July 1,  
17 2004, at Los Angeles, California. At the time of his death, he was  
18 a resident of Los Angeles County, California.

19 4) Letters Testamentary Issued: Letters Testamentary were  
20 issued to Petitioners on September 2, 2004. At all times since  
21 then, Petitioners have been and now are the Executors of the  
22 Decedent's estate.

23 5) Order Approving First Account Current, Report and  
24 Petition and for Preliminary Distribution and Report of Status of  
25 Administration of Executors and Petition: On October 3, 2005, the  
26 Court issued an Order Approving the First Account Current, and  
27 Report of Status of Administration of Executors and Petition for:  
28 (1) Settlement Thereof: (2) For Allowance on Account of Executors'

1 and Attorneys' Statutory Commissions and Fees, and Extraordinary  
2 Attorneys' Fees; (3) Preliminary Distribution to Trustees; (4)  
3 Extension of Time for Administration of the Estate; and (5)  
4 Decreased Bond, filed by the Petitioners. The First Account  
5 Current, Report and Petition covered the period from Decedent's  
6 death on July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005.

7 **6) Authority and Actions Taken Under Independent**

8 **Administration of Estate's Act:** Petitioners were granted full  
9 authority by order of this court to administer the estate without  
10 court supervision under the Independent Administration of Estates  
11 Act and took the following action without court supervision in  
12 addition to the actions reported in the First Account Current,  
13 Report and Petition:

14 a) Consummated a mediated Agreement dated December 22, 2005,  
15 by and between the Estate and Maria Cristina Ruiz, individually and  
16 as guardian of Ninna Brando, Myles Brando and Timothy Brando, after  
17 providing Notice of Proposed Action. No objections to the Notice of  
18 Proposed Action were filed.

19 b) Sold the Decedent's real property located at 9031  
20 Wonderland Avenue, Los Angeles, CA (APN 5564-031-034 & 5564-031-  
21 029) for \$465,000 after providing the required Notice of Proposed  
22 Action. The sale resulted in a gain against the \$330,000 carry  
23 value of the real property in the amount of \$135,000. No objections  
24 to the Notice of Proposed Action were filed.

25 c) Consummated a mediated Agreement dated December 20, 2006,  
26 by and between the Estate, Executors, and Angela Borlaza Magaling,  
27 after providing Notice of Proposed Action. No objections to the  
28 Notice of Proposed Action were filed.

1           7) Inventory and Appraisal: Petitioners filed the following  
2 Inventory and Appraisals.

7     As set forth in the above listed inventories and appraisals,  
8 the total value of all property is \$11,772,931.46.

9           8) Nature of Estate Property: As set forth in the First  
10 Account Current, Report and Petition, at the time of his death, the  
11 Decedent was not married. All estate property inventoried in these  
12 probate proceedings was the Decedent's separate property.

13          9) Notice to Creditors & Creditor's Claim Period: As set  
14 forth in the Second and Final Account, Report and Petition, Notice  
15 of Death and Petition to Administer the Estate was published in the  
16 manner prescribed by law, and within thirty (30) days after  
17 completion of publication an Affidavit showing publication was  
18 filed with the court. A Notice of Administration to Creditors was  
19 mailed to all known and reasonably ascertainable creditors of  
20 Decedent. The time for filing or presenting creditor's claims has  
21 expired.

22          10) Disposition of Creditor's Claims: Eighteen (18)  
23 creditors' claims were filed in these proceedings as set forth in  
24 EXHIBIT 1 of the Petition which contains updated details of the  
25 status of all fully paid, partially paid, and rejected creditor's  
26 claims. All claims have been acted on, and the limitations periods  
27 for maintaining actions on all rejected claims has expired and/or  
28 the litigation on the claims has concluded.

1           11)     Payment of Bona Fide Debts Probate Code §9154: All bona  
2 fide debts of the Decedent paid by Petitioners were set forth in  
3 the First Account Current, Report and Petition.

4           12)     Medi-Cal Notice: No notice to the California Department  
5 of Health Services was required under Probate Code Section 9202  
6 because the decedent did not receive and was not the surviving  
7 spouse of a person who received any Medi-Cal benefits.

8           13)     Tax Clearance Certificate. The sole residuary  
9 beneficiary of the Estate is a trust resident in California and  
10 whose Trustees are all residents of California. Therefore, a  
11 Franchise Tax Board Income Tax Certificate is not required.

12           14)     Personal Property Taxes: The estate owes no personal  
13 property taxes.

14           15)     Income Taxes: The decedent's final personal income tax  
15 returns have been filed and all tax owing has been paid. By their  
16 signatures hereon, Petitioners, as Trustees of the Marlon Brando  
17 Living Trust, u/d/t dated August 28, 2002 (the "Trust"), have  
18 assumed responsibility for the preparation and filing of the  
19 Estate's final income tax returns and the payment of any tax due  
20 thereon.

21           16)     Federal and California Estate Tax: A Federal Estate Tax  
22 Return has been filed for the Decedent's estate state showing a  
23 total tax liability of \$2,042,121.00, and a California Estate Tax  
24 Return showing a total tax liability of \$127,221.00, all of which  
25 has been paid. Petitioners have not received a closing letter from  
26 the Internal Revenue Service and an audit of the return is in  
27 progress. Petitioners have not been released from liability for  
28 payment of possible further estate tax which may be owing.

1 Petitioners, as Trustees of the Trust, have assumed any liability  
2 relating to the estate tax returns of Decedent.

3 17) Summary of Account: Petitioners are chargeable with the  
4 sums, and are entitled to the credits, respectively, as set forth  
5 in this Summary of Account covering the period from July 1, 2005  
6 through and including January 31, 2007:

23 18) Property on Hand for Distribution: Assets on hand for  
24 distribution are in the sum of \$3,715,211, consisting of cash,  
25 various business interests and intellectual property rights.

26 19) Status of Administration: The estate is in a condition  
27 to be closed. Petitioners have performed all duties required of  
28 them as Executors of the Estate. All costs of administration



1 incurred to date have been paid except the attorneys' fees and  
2 costs sought herein.

3       20) Preliminary Distributions Completed: During the period of  
4 the First Account Current, Petitioners made distributions of the  
5 decedent's personal property not sold at auction, having a value of  
6 \$32,658, to the decedent's children, and monthly cash payments of  
7 \$2,700 to Alice Marchak and \$1,200 to Blanche Hall. These  
8 distributions were approved by the Court. With Court approval, and  
9 as set forth in the October 3, 2005 Order Approving First Account  
10 Current, the following assets were distributed to Petitioners, as  
11 Trustees of the Marlon Brando Living Trust, u/d/t dated August 28,  
12 2002:

13       a) Cash from Sale of tangible personal property in the sum of  
14 \$1,997,750.00.

15       b) 100% interest in intellectual property rights related to  
16 name and likeness of Marlon Brando valued at \$1,354,600.00.

17       c) Cash in the sum of \$319,529.00 for the purchase annuities  
18 for Alice Marchak and Blanche Hall.

19       21) Proposed Distribution of Estate. The residue of the  
20 Estate, whether now on hand, known or hereafter discovered, is  
21 distributable to Petitioners as Trustees of the Marlon Brando  
22 Living Trust u/d/t dated August 28, 2002.

23       22) Payment of Executors' Statutory Commissions:

24       Petitioners are entitled to total statutory compensation of  
25 \$151,050.10. As approved by the Court, statutory compensation has  
26 been paid to Petitioners in the amount of \$93,766.57. The Court  
27 should direct payment of the remaining statutory compensation of  
28

1 \$57,283.53 to Petitioners for services rendered as Executors of the  
2 Estate.

3 23) Payment of Extraordinary Executors' Commissions: The  
4 reasonable value of extraordinary services performed by the  
5 Petitioners during the period of the Second Account and for the  
6 benefit of the Estate as follows, and the Court should direct  
7 payment to Petitioners of: \$18,750 to Larry J. Dressler, \$15,625 to  
8 Avra Douglas, and \$7,875 to Morris M. Medavoy.

9 24) Payment of Attorneys' Statutory Fees: Petitioners engaged  
10 the Law Offices of Charles A. Larson to provide legal services to  
11 the estate. The attorneys have rendered legal services, and the  
12 statutory fee for such services is \$151,050.10. Pursuant to Court  
13 Order, \$93,766.57 of the statutory fees have been paid to the Law  
14 Offices of Charles Larson. The Court should direct payment of the  
15 remaining statutory fee of \$57,283.53 to the Law Offices of Charles  
16 Larson for services rendered as attorneys for the Executors of the  
17 Estate.

18 25) Payment of Extraordinary Attorneys' Fees: The reasonable  
19 value of extraordinary legal services performed by the Law Offices  
20 of Charles A. Larson during the period of the Second Account and  
21 for the benefit of the Estate is \$142,022.50. The Court should  
22 direct Petitioner to pay the Law Offices of Charles A. Larson  
23 \$142,022.50 as compensation for extraordinary services.

24 26) Reimbursement of Costs Advanced: Petitioners' attorneys  
25 the Law Offices of Charles A. Larson advanced \$849.46 to the Estate  
26 for administrative costs. The Court should direct Petitioner to pay  
27 the Law Offices of Charles A. Larson \$849.46 as reimbursement of  
28 costs advanced.

1           27) Graduated Filing Fee Refund: As set forth in the Schedule  
2 for Graduated Filing Fee Information contained in the Petition, a  
3 filing fee refund is due to the Estate in the amount of \$21,625.55  
4 and the Court should direct payment of that refund to Petitioners  
5 as Trustees of the Marlon Brando Living Trust u/d/t dated August  
6 28, 2002.

7           **THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:**

8           1.     The Second and Final Account and Report of Status of  
9 Administration is settled, allowed and approved as filed.

10          2.     All the acts and transactions of the Petitioners are  
11 ratified, approved and confirmed.

12          3.     Petitioners are authorized and directed to pay to  
13 themselves the sum of \$57,283.53 as remaining statutory fees for  
14 services rendered, and for extraordinary services rendered during  
15 the period of the Second and Final Account, are authorized and  
16 directed to pay \$18,750 to Larry J. Dressler, \$15,625 to Avra  
17 Douglas, and \$7,875 to Morris M. Medavoy.

18          4.     Petitioners are authorized and directed to pay to the Law  
19 Offices of Charles A. Larson the sum of \$57,283.53 as remaining  
20 statutory fees for services rendered, \$142,022.50 for extraordinary  
21 services rendered during the period of the Second and Final  
22 Account, and \$849.46 as reimbursement for costs advanced.

23          5.     The Court shall refund filing fees due to the Estate in  
24 the amount of \$21,625.55 by payment to Larry J. Dressler, Morris M.  
25 Medavoy and Avra Douglas as Trustees of the Marlon Brando Living  
26 Trust u/d/t dated August 28, 2002.

27          6.     Distribution of the Estate of Decedent in Petitioners  
28 hands and of any other property of Decedent or the Estate not now

1 known or which may hereafter be discovered be made to Larry J.  
2 Dressler, Morris M. Medavoy and Avra Douglas, as Trustees of the  
3 Marlon Brando Living Trust, u/d/t dated August 28, 2002; and
