Re: Application to Convert to a Colorado State Chartered Commercial Bank

Dear Mr. Olson:

At its January 17, 2008 meeting, the Colorado State Banking Board (Board) approved the application of First National Bank (Bank), Julesburg, Colorado to convert to a Colorado state-chartered commercial bank, including the Bank's continued eligibility as a public depository. The Bank, renamed Points West Community Bank, will continue to be headquartered at 100 East 3rd Street, Julesburg, Colorado and the existing branch locations will become branches of the converted bank.

In making its determination, the Board relied on representations made in the application. Should there be a substantive change in any of the information provided, please notify the Division of Banking (Division) staff at once. The Division will need a copy of any required notification or approval from the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency and the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City. The Articles of Incorporation (Articles) that have been stamped "Approved for Filing" by the Division are enclosed. When the Bank is prepared to consummate the conversion, please provide a copy of the Articles that have been stamped "Filed" by the Colorado Secretary of State and submit a letter to the Division providing the following information:

1. Proposed date of actual conversion;
2. Name identifying each branch banking facility;
3. Name and title of the person responsible for the overall operation of the bank and each branch;
4. Physical address of the main office and each branch (including street, city, state, and zip code);
5. Mailing address of the main office and each branch (if different from the physical address); and
6. Telephone and facsimile number of the main office and each branch.

The requested information should be sent to the attention of Antoinette (Toni) Clair, the Division's liaison for the Bank for purposes of this conversion. A Colorado state bank Charter will be issued by the Division upon receipt of the requested information; and if the Bank would like to have Branch Banking Certificates for each of its branch banking facilities, please make that request at the same time.
