
Joseph M. Casciani, PhD and Donald J. Quackenbush certify that:


1. They are the president and secretary, respectively, of Senior Psychology Services, Inc., a California corporation.
2. Article I of the articles of incorporation of this corporation is amended to read as follows:

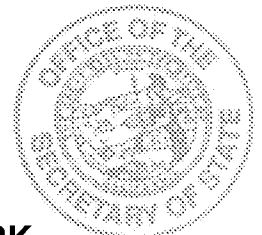
"The name of the corporation is VERICORE PSYCHOLOGY, INC."
