## ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARK

This ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARK is made as of the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October, 2006, by HUGHY. OKUDA, whose address is 337 Uluniu Street, Suite 203, Kailua, Hawaii, 96734, and DAVID BLACK, whose address is 17 Barkentine Road, Rancho Palos Verdes, California 90275, jointly as "Assignors," in favor of 3061868 CANADA INC., a corporation organized under the laws of Canada, the principal office and mailing address of which is 5764 Paré Street, Montreal, Quebec, H4P 2M2, as "Assignee," with reference to the following facts:

A. On April 22, 1969, the trademark "AUTOSTART" (the "Mark") was registered by Systematics, Inc., a Minnesota corporation, in the United States Patent and Trademark Office as Registration No. 868,378. The registration was renewed on March 20, 1989. A copy of said registration is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

B. On September 22, 2004, Systematics, Inc., assigned all of its right, title and interest in and to the Mark to Assignors.

C. Assignors have agreed to sell and assign the Mark to Assignee, and Assignee has agreed to purchase the Mark from Assignors.

NOW, THEREFORE, Assignors agree as follows:

1. Assignment of Mark. For a valuable consideration paid to Assignors by Assignee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by Assignors, Assignors do hereby sell, assign, transfer and convey to Assignee all of Assignors' right, title and interest in and to the Mark, together with any and all interest of Assignors in and to the goodwill of the business with which the Mark has heretofore been used or associated and which is symbolized by the Mark.



Assignors agree to execute and deliver at the request of Assignee all papers, instruments and assignments, and to perform any other reasonable acts Assignee may request, in order to vest all of Assignors' rights, title, and interest in and to the Mark in the Assignee and/or to provide evidence to support any of the foregoing in the event such evidence is deemed necessary by Assignee, to the extent such evidence is in the possession or control of Assignors.



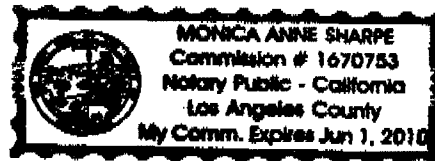
