PATENT AND TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

THIS PATENT AND TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT (this "Assignment"), dated as of September 1, 2009 (the "Effective Date"), is made by and between POLYMER GROUP, INC., a Delaware corporation ("Assignor"), and FABPRO ORIENTED POLYMERS, L.L.C., a Delaware limited liability company ("Assignee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of (a) the patent(s) and/or patent application(s) identified in Schedule 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; (b) the trademarks and the registrations and applications for registration thereof identified in Schedule 1, and the goodwill of the business associated therewith and symbolized thereby; and (c) the domain names identified on Schedule 1 hereto (items (a) through (c) are referred to herein collectively as the "Intellectual Property");

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Assignment, Assignor and Assignee agree as follows:

1. Assignment.

(a) As of the Effective Date, Assignor hereby irrevocably conveys, grants, assigns, transfers, and delivers to Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, all of Assignor's worldwide right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property and the goodwill of the business associated therewith and symbolized thereby, together with all rights appurtenant thereto, including any related or corresponding United States provisional or non-provisional application embodying the inventions or any other United States application claiming priority to a provisional application under 35 U.S.C. §119(e) or converted therefrom, or to any application claiming the benefit of a non-provisional application under 35 U.S.C. §120, including all divisions, continuations and continuations-in-part thereof, and all patents of the United States that may be granted thereon and all reissues and extensions thereof; and all applications for industrial property protection based on the Intellectual Property, including, without limitation, all applications for patents, utility models, and designs that may hereafter be filed in any country or countries other than the United States, together with the right to file such applications and the right to claim for the same the priority rights derived from said United States application under the Patent Laws of the United States, the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in which any such application is filed, as may be applicable; and all forms of industrial property protection based on the Intellectual Property, including, without limitation, patents, utility models, inventors' certificates and designs which may be granted for the Intellectual Property in any country or countries foreign to the United States and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof, the same to be held and enjoyed by Assignee, and all rights to bring actions at law or in equity for the past, present and future infringements, misappropriations or other violations of any of the foregoing, including all income, royalties, damages, payments, accounts and accounts receivable now or hereafter due and/or payable under and with respect thereto.

(b) Assignor agrees that Assignee will hold all right, title and interest to the Intellectual Property, which are for Assignee's own use and the use of its successors, assigns and legal representatives, as fully and exclusively as the Intellectual Property would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had the assignment hereunder not been made.

(c) Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any Official of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to issue patents or other evidence or forms of industrial property protection on applications as aforesaid, to issue the same to Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, in accordance with the terms of this instrument.





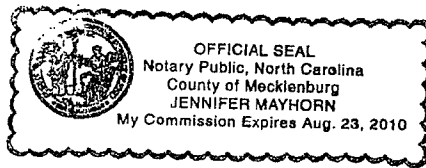
