NUNC PRO TUNC ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARK


WHEREAS, LTX-Credence Corporation, the successor in interest via merger to Credence Systems Corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and having its principal place of business at 1355 California Circle, Milpitas, CA 95035 (hereinafter referred to as "Assignor") is the owner of United States Trademark Registration No. 2,696,016, for the mark EMISCOPE (the "Mark");

AND, WHEREAS, DCG Systems, Inc., a corporation of the State of Delaware, having its principal place of business at 45900 Northport Loop East, Fremont, CA 94537 (hereinafter referred to as the "Assignee"), acquired the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the Mark effective as of February 20, 2008;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt, sufficiency and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor has sold, assigned and transferred and by these presents does hereby sell, assign and transfer *nunc pro tunc* as of February 20, 2008, unto said Assignee, the entire right, title and interest in and to said Mark, together with the good will of the business symbolized by said Mark, within the United States of America and its territorial possessions and all foreign counterparts, all said rights to be held and enjoyed by Assignee for its own use and enjoyment and for the use and enjoyment of its successors and assigns as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if the assignment, transfer and sale had not been made, including any rights of the Assignor to sue any third parties for any past infringement of or to the Mark.
