RELEASE OF COLLATERAL ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARKS AS SECURITY

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2003, THE HUDSON-SHARP MACHINE COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware (the "Borrower") and BANK ONE, N.A., a national banking association ("Bank One") entered into a Collateral Assignment of Trademarks as Security (the "Initial Security Agreement"), pursuant to which the Borrower assigned to Bank One all of its right, title and interest in, to and under certain trademarks owned by the Borrower (the "Collateral"), which Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on July 18, 2003 in Reel 2967, frame 0602 and

WHEREAS, JP Morgan Chase Bank, N.A., a national banking association, (the "Lender") is the successor by merger to Bank One; and

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2005, the Borrower and the Lender entered into a First Amendment to Collateral Assignment of Trademarks as Security Agreement (the "Amendment Agreement") (the Initial Security Agreement and the Amendment Agreement are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Security Agreement"), pursuant to which the Borrower acknowledged that the Lender is the secured party under the Security Agreement, which Amendment Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on April 5, 2005 in Reel 3059, frame 0913; and

WHEREAS, the obligations secured by the Security Agreement have been paid in full and the Lenders no longer claims a security interest or any other interest in the Collateral under the Security Agreement or otherwise.

This Agreement may be executed in any number of duplicate originals or counterparts, each of such duplicate originals or counterparts shall be deemed to be an original and all taken together shall constitute but one and the same instrument.


NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Lender hereby expressly releases and discharges its security interest in and to the Collateral (which Collateral is further described on Schedule A attached hereto and incorporated herein) and reassign, without representation, warranty or recourse, to Borrower all of the Lender's right, title and interest in and to the Collateral.
