THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court by B. Moss Clothing Company Ltd., the within debtor and debtor-in-possession (the “Debtor”), by and through its counsel, Cole, Schotz, Meisel, Forman & Leonard, P.A., upon the filing of an Information for Notice of Private Sale by the Debtor (Docket No. 287) (the “Sale Notice”, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit A**), pursuant to which the Debtor seeks to sell its right, title and interest in and to all of its intangible property as described in the Sale Notice (the “Intangible Property”) to Fred Krawchick (“Krawchick”) pursuant to the terms set forth in the Sale Notice (the “Sale”) and good and sufficient notice of the Sale Notice having been provided to all parties-in-interest, as evidenced by the Affidavit of Service filed with the Court; and the Office of the United States Trustee having filed a limited objection to the Sale Notice (Docket No. 304)(the “Limited Objection”), and the parties having resolved the Limited Objection, and no other objections having been filed to the Sale Notice, and no higher or better offers having been made for the Intangible Property; and the Court having considered the Sale Notice, and it appearing that the Sale is necessary and in the best interests of the Debtor, its creditors, estate and other parties-in-interest; and due deliberation having been had; and good cause appearing for the entry of this Order;

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. The Sale is hereby approved pursuant to the terms set forth in the Sale Notice.

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2. The Debtor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to Krawchick all documents, and to take such action, as may be necessary to fulfill the terms and provisions of the Sale.

3. Pursuant to Section 363(f) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Sale shall be free and clear of all liens, claims, encumbrances, and interests of any kind and nature, with any valid liens or security interests to attach to the Sale proceeds in the same order of priority as they existed before the Sale.

4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to interpret, implement and enforce the terms and provisions of this Order, and enter Orders in aid or furtherance of this Order.

5. A true copy of this Order shall be served on all parties-in-interest by first class mail within five (5) days of the date hereof.
