As a result of the judgment entered against you, the bank or other person holding your money or property has been ordered by this court to hold your money or property subject to further order of the court. You may be entitled to claim an exemption of all or part of your money or property, but in order to do so you must file a motion with the court as soon as possible. If you do not file a motion within 30 days after service on the Garnishee, your property may be turned over to the Judgment Creditor. You may include in your motion a request for a hearing. 


