TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT

THIS TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT, dated as of April 30, 2010, is made by each of the entities listed on the signature pages hereof (each a "Grantor" and, collectively, the "Grantors"), in favor of General Electric Capital Corporation ("GE Capital"), as Lessor (the "Lessor") and the other Secured Parties.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Master Lease Agreement (Quasi), dated as of June 8, 2007 (as amended, restated, supplemented, replaced or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Lease Agreement"), by and between the Company and Lessor, Lessor has, or from time to time may, lease to Grantor various items of equipment;

WHEREAS, the Lessor has consented to the assignment by AMDS, Inc. to, and the assumption by, Grantor of the duties and obligations of AMDS, Inc. under the Lease Agreement (the "Assignment and Assumption Agreement");

WHEREAS, each Grantor has agreed, pursuant to that certain Cross-Collateral Agreement of even date herewith (as the same may be amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Cross-Collateral Agreement"), pursuant to which each Grantor is required to grant a security interest in the Collateral;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and to induce the Lessor to enter into the Assignment and Assumption Agreement, Grantor hereby agrees with the Lessor as follows:

Section 1. Defined Terms. Capitalized terms used herein without definition are used as defined in the Cross-Collateral Agreement.

Section 2. Grant of Security Interest in Trademark Collateral. Each Grantor, as collateral security for the prompt payment and performance when due (whether at stated maturity, by acceleration or otherwise) of the MLA Obligations of such Grantor, hereby mortgages, pledges and hypothecates to the Lessor, and grants to the Lessor a Lien on and security interest in, all of its right, title and interest in, to and under the following Collateral of such Grantor (the "Trademark Collateral"):

(a) all of its Trademarks and all IP Licenses providing for the grant by or to such Grantor of any right under any Trademark, including, without limitation, those referred to on Schedule 1 hereto;

(a) all renewals and extensions of the foregoing;

(b) all goodwill of the business connected with the use of, and symbolized by, each such Trademark; and

(c) all income, royalties, proceeds and Liabilities at any time due or payable or asserted under and with respect to any of the foregoing, including, without limitation, all rights to sue and recover at law or in equity for any past, present and future infringement, misappropriation, dilution, violation or other impairment thereof.

For the avoidance of doubt, Trademark Collateral shall not include any Excluded Property; provided, however, that if and when any property of the type set forth above shall cease to be Excluded Property, a Lien on and security in such property shall be deemed granted therein.

Section 3. Cross-Collateral Agreement. The security interest granted pursuant to this Trademark Security Agreement is granted in conjunction with the security interest granted to the Lessor pursuant to the Cross-Collateral Agreement and each Grantor hereby acknowledges and agrees that the rights and remedies of the Lessor with respect to the security interest in the Trademark Collateral made and granted hereby are more fully set forth in the Cross-Collateral Agreement, the terms and provisions of which are incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth herein.

Section 4. Grantor Remains Liable. Each Grantor hereby agrees that, anything herein to the contrary notwithstanding, such Grantor shall assume full and complete responsibility for the prosecution, defense, enforcement or any other necessary or desirable actions in connection with their Trademarks and IP Licenses subject to a security interest hereunder.

Section 5. Counterparts. This Trademark Security Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and by different parties in separate counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Signature pages may be detached from multiple separate counterparts and attached to a single counterpart.




