TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

This TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT ("Assignment"), dated as of January 4, 2010 (the "Effective Date"), is made by and between REEBOK INTERNATIONAL LTD ("Assignor") and Collective Brands Cooperatief U.A. ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of the Trademarks and the corresponding United States trademark registrations and applications identified on Exhibit A, together with the goodwill of the business associated therewith or symbolized thereby (collectively, the "Trademarks");

WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee have entered into that certain Trademark Assignment and License Agreement, dated as of, January 4, 2010 (the "Agreement"), pursuant to which Assignor assigned certain intellectual property, including the Trademarks, to Assignee;


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and covenants set forth herein and in the Agreement and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignment. Assignor hereby assigns to Assignee any and all right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks, the corresponding applications and/or registrations for the Trademarks, the right to recover for past infringement of the Trademarks, the goodwill associated with the Trademarks, and including, for any applications for the Trademarks filed under Section 1(b) of the Trademark Act for which no amendment under Section 1(c) of the Trademark Act or no verified statement of use under Section 1(d) of the Trademark Act has been filed, that portion of the ongoing and existing business to which such Trademarks pertain.
2. Purpose. This Agreement has been executed and delivered by the Assignor for the purpose of recording the assignment herein with the United States Patent and Trademark Office. The assignment granted herein has been granted pursuant to the Agreement and is expressly subject to the terms and conditions thereof. In the event of any conflict between the terms of this Assignment and the terms of the Agreement, the terms of the Agreement shall control.
3. Cooperation. The parties shall cooperate to execute and deliver such other documents and take all such other actions as reasonably necessary to effect the intent hereof.
4. Counterparts. This Assignment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.





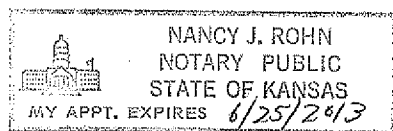
