DEED OF ASSIGNMENT

THIS DEED OF ASSIGNMENT ("the Assignment") is made and entered into as of June 1st, 2010 ("the Effective Date"), by and among Coatex Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Assignor") and Coatex SAS, a French Corporation ("Assignee")

WHEREAS Assignor, by virtue of a Bill of Sale and Assignment dated January 25 2010, was assigned certain assets from Arkema Inc, a Pennsylvania corporation ("Arkema Inc"), relating to the Polyphobe business ("the Polyphobe Assets"), previously owned by the Dow Chemical Company, a Delaware corporation,

WHEREAS the Polyphobe Assets include among other things, that certain patents and patents applications, trademarks and copyrights listed in Exhibit A hereunder (collectively "the Polyphobe IP Rights").

WHEREAS, effective as of the Effective Date, Assignor desires to assign all of its rights and obligations with respect to the Polyphobe IP Rights to its Affiliate, Assignee, and Assignee desires to accept and assume such rights and obligations under the Polyphobes IP Rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Assignment

(a) Effective as of the Effective Date, Assignor hereby irrevocably assign, conveys, transfers and delivers to Assignee all of its right, title and interest in, to and under the patent and patent applications listed under Exhibit A.1 ("the Polyphobe Patents") and all of Assignor's obligations with respect to the Polyphobe Patents under that certain Intellectual Property Assignment and License Back Agreement ("the IP Assignment Agreement") entered into by Arkema Inc and TDDC as part of the transactions contemplated under the asset purchase agreement of the Polyphobe Assets signed between them, subject to and in accordance with the provisions of Section 9.11 of the IP Assignment Agreement, and Assignee hereby agrees to accept and assume such rights and obligations of Assignor.

(b) Effective as of the Effective Date, Assignor hereby irrevocably assign, conveys, transfers and delivers to Assignee all of its rights, title and interest in, to and under the trademarks and copyrights listed under Exhibit A.2 ("the Polyphobe Trademarks and Copyrights"), and Assignee hereby agrees to accept and assume such rights of Assignor.

2. Effect of Assignment

As of the Effective Date, Assignee shall have all of the rights and obligations of Assignor under the IP Assignment Agreement with respect to the Polyphobe IP Rights.

3. Recording

Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the United States Patent & Trademark Office to record Assignee as the owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to Polyphobe IP Rights.

4. Successors and Assigns

This Assignment shall be binding upon, and shall inure to the benefit of the Parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.

5. Governing law

This Agreement shall be construed, performed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of France, without giving effect to its principles or rules of conflict of laws.
