

**AMENDED AND RESTATED
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT**

THIS AMENDED AND RESTATED INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT, dated as of September 28, 2010 (this "Agreement"), is made by DUANE STREET LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Grantor"), in favor of ISRAEL DISCOUNT BANK OF NEW YORK ("Lender").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Polarome International Inc., a New York corporation ("Seller") to secure its obligations and liabilities to Lender under the Loan and Security Agreement dated as of June 13, 2007, as amended, modified and supplemented (the "Existing Loan Agreement") executed and delivered an Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated as of June 13, 2007 in favor of Lender, as amended, modified and supplemented (the "Existing Intellectual Property Security Agreement");

WHEREAS, in connection with Grantor's acquisition of the assets of Seller used in its business, Grantor has assumed the obligations and liabilities of Seller to Lender, including without limitation, under the Existing Loan Agreement and the Existing Intellectual Property Security Agreement;

WHEREAS, Grantor and Lender are amending and restating the Existing Loan Agreement pursuant to the Amended and Restated Loan and Security Agreement dated as of the date hereof by and between Grantor and Lender (as from time to time amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified, the "Loan Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, in connection therewith Grantor is executing and delivering to Lender this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Grantor hereby agrees as follows:

1. Amendment and Restatement. As of the date of this Agreement, the terms, conditions, covenants, agreements, representations and warranties contained in the Existing Intellectual Property Security Agreement shall be deemed amended and restated in their entirety as set forth in this Agreement; provided, however, that nothing contained in this Agreement shall impair, limit or affect the liens and security interests heretofore granted, pledged and/or assigned to Lender under the Existing Intellectual Property Security Agreement. Grantor reaffirms the liens and security interests granted pursuant to the Existing Intellectual Property Security Agreement which liens and security interests, to Grantor's knowledge, continue in full force and effect.

2. DEFINED TERMS. All capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein have the meanings given to them in the Loan Agreement and the following terms shall have the following meanings, unless the context otherwise requires:

“Copyrights” shall mean all copyrights and rights and interests in copyrights and works protectable by copyright and all renewals and extensions thereof, all copyright registrations and applications for registration of any such copyrights in the United States of America or any other country, including, without limitation, (a) all copyrights, distribution rights, licenses, and any and all other rights or interests in copyrights in the works listed on Schedule III attached hereto and made a part hereof, (b) all works based upon, incorporated in, derived from, incorporating or relating to all works covered by copyright and (c) all tangible property embodying the copyrights or such copyrights materials.

“Copyright Licenses” shall mean the copyright license agreements of Grantor designated on Schedule III hereto, as any of the same may from time to time be amended, modified or supplemented.

“Patents” shall mean all right, title and interest in and to the patent applications and patents shown in the attached Schedule I and those patents which are hereafter obtained or acquired by Grantor and all registrations, applications and recordings thereof, including, without limitation, all reissues, divisions, continuations, renewals, extensions and continuations-in-part thereof, and all applications, registrations and recordings in the United States Patent and Trademark Office or in any similar office or agency of the United States, or any State thereof, or any foreign country, all whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor.

“Patent Licenses” shall mean the patent license agreements of Grantor designated on Schedule I hereto, as any of the same may from time to time be amended, modified or supplemented.

“Trademarks” shall mean the registered trademarks and pending applications shown in the attached Schedule II, and those trademarks which are hereafter adopted or acquired by Grantor, and all right, title and interest therein and thereto, and all registrations, applications, and recordings thereof, including, without limitation, applications, registrations and recordings in the United States Patent and Trademark Office or in any similar office or agency of the United States, any State thereof, or any foreign country, all whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor.

“Trademark Licenses” shall mean the trademark license agreements of Grantor designated on Schedule II hereto, as any of the same may from time to time be amended, modified or supplemented.

3. GRANT OF SECURITY INTEREST IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY COLLATERAL. To secure the complete and timely payment of all the Obligations of Grantor now or hereafter existing from time to time, Grantor hereby pledges and grants to Lender a continuing first priority security interest in all of Grantor’s right, title and interest in, to and under the following, whether presently existing or hereafter created or acquired (collectively, the “Intellectual Property Collateral”):

- (a) all of its Patents and Patent Licenses;
- (b) all of its Trademarks and Trademark Licenses;

- (c) all of its Copyrights and Copyright Licenses;
- (d) all reissues, continuations or extensions of the foregoing;
- (e) all goodwill of the business connected with the use of, and symbolized by, each Patent, each Patent License, each Trademark, each Trademark License, each Copyright and each Copyright License; and
- (f) all products and proceeds of the foregoing, including, without limitation, any claim by Grantor against third parties for past, present or future (i) infringement or dilution of any Patent or Patent licensed under any Patent License, (ii) injury to the goodwill associated with any Patent or any Patent licensed under any Patent License, (iii) infringement or dilution of any Trademark or Trademark licensed under any Trademark License, (iv) injury to the goodwill associated with any Trademark or any Trademark licensed under any Trademark License, (v) infringement or dilution of any Copyright or Copyright licensed under any Copyright License, and (vi) injury to the goodwill associated with any Copyright or any Copyright licensed under any Copyright License.

4. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES. Grantor represents and warrants that Grantor does not have any interest in, or title to, any Patent, Trademark or Copyright except as set forth in Schedule I, Schedule II and Schedule III, respectively, hereto. This Agreement is effective to create a valid and continuing Lien in favor of Lender on all of Grantor's Patents, Trademarks and Copyrights. Upon the filing hereof of appropriate financing statements and the filing of a copy of this Agreement with the United States Patent and Trademark Office and the United States Copyright Office, Lender will have a perfected security interest in all of Grantor's Patents, Trademarks and Copyrights in which Grantor has rights in the United States, if any, and such perfected security interest is enforceable as such as against any and all creditors of, and purchasers from, Grantor.

5. COVENANTS. Grantor covenants and agrees with Lender that from and after the date of this Agreement and until the Obligations have been paid in full in cash and the Loan Agreement has been irrevocably terminated:

(a) Grantor shall notify Lender immediately if it knows or has reason to know that any application or registration relating to any Patent, Trademark or Copyright (now or hereafter existing) may become abandoned or dedicated, or of any adverse determination or development (including the institution of, or any such determination or development in, any proceeding in the United States Patent and Trademark Office, the United States Copyright Office or any court) regarding Grantor's ownership of any Patent, Trademark or Copyright, its right to register the same, or to keep and maintain the same.

(b) In no event shall Grantor, either directly or through any agent, employee, licensee or designee, file an application for the registration of any Patent, Trademark or Copyright with the United States Patent and Trademark Office, the United States Copyright Office or any similar office or agency without giving Lender prior written notice thereof, and, upon request of Lender, Grantor shall execute and deliver a supplement hereto (in form and

substance satisfactory to Lender) to evidence Lender's Lien on such Patent, Trademark or Copyright, and the general intangibles of Grantor relating thereto or represented thereby.

(c) Grantor shall take all actions necessary or requested by Lender to maintain and pursue each application, to obtain the relevant registration and to maintain the registration of each of the Patents or Trademarks (now or hereafter existing), including the filing of applications for renewal, affidavits of use, affidavits of noncontestability and opposition and interference and cancellation proceedings.

(d) In the event that any of the Intellectual Property Collateral is infringed upon, or misappropriated or diluted by a third party, Grantor shall notify Lender promptly after Grantor learns thereof. Grantor shall, unless it shall reasonably determine that such Intellectual Property Collateral is in no way material to the conduct of its business or operations, promptly sue for infringement, misappropriation or dilution and to recover any and all damages for such infringement, misappropriation or dilution, and shall take such other actions as Lender shall deem appropriate under the circumstances to protect such Intellectual Property Collateral.

6. SECURITY AGREEMENT. The security interests granted pursuant to this Agreement are granted in conjunction with the security interests granted to Lender pursuant to the Loan Agreement. Grantor hereby acknowledges and affirms that the rights and remedies of Lender with respect to the security interest in the Intellectual Property Collateral made and granted hereby are more fully set forth in the Loan Agreement, the terms and provisions of which are incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth herein.

7. REINSTATEMENT. This Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and continue to be effective should any petition be filed by or against Grantor for liquidation or reorganization, should Grantor become insolvent or make an assignment for the benefit of any creditor or creditors or should a receiver or trustee be appointed for all or any significant part of Grantor's assets, and shall continue to be effective or be reinstated, as the case may be, if at any time payment and performance of the Obligations, or any part thereof, is, pursuant to applicable law, rescinded or reduced in amount, or must otherwise be restored or returned by any obligee of the Obligations, whether as a "voidable preference," "fraudulent conveyance," or otherwise, all as though such payment or performance had not been made. In the event that any payment, or any part thereof, is rescinded, reduced, restored or returned, the Obligations shall be reinstated and deemed reduced only by such amount paid and not so rescinded, reduced, restored or returned.

8. NOTICES. Whenever it is provided herein that any notice, demand, request, consent, approval, declaration or other communication shall or may be given to or served upon any of the parties by any other party, or whenever any of the parties desires to give and serve upon any other party any communication with respect to this Agreement, each such notice, demand, request, consent, approval, declaration or other communication shall be in writing and shall be given in the manner, and deemed received, as provided for in the Loan Agreement.

9. TERMINATION OF THIS SECURITY AGREEMENT. Subject to Section 7 hereof, this Intellectual Property Security Agreement shall terminate upon payment of the Obligations in full in cash and the irrevocable termination of the Loan Agreement.
