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INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT

This INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT (this “**Agreement**”) dated as of October 1, 2010, by and among DIALOGIC CORPORATION, a British Columbia corporation (the “**Company**”), DIALOGIC INC., a Delaware corporation (the “**Parent**”), each of the Subsidiaries of the Company and the Parent identified under the caption “Subsidiary Grantors” on the signature pages hereto or which from time to time may become party hereto as contemplated herein (individually, a “**Subsidiary Grantor**” and, collectively, the “**Subsidiary Grantors**” and, together with the Company and the Parent, the “**Obligors**”); and OBSIDIAN, LLC, as agent (in such capacity, together with its successors in such capacity, the “**Collateral Agent**”) for the Secured Parties. Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings given to them in the Security Agreement (as defined below).

The Obligors, the Collateral Agent and Obsidian, LLC, as administrative agent (in such capacity, the “**Administrative Agent**”) are parties to that certain Second Amended and Restated Credit Agreement dated as of October 1, 2010 (as amended, restated, modified or supplemented and in effect from time to time, the “**Credit Agreement**”), pursuant to which the Lender Parties have agreed to make certain financial accommodations to the Company.

To induce the Lenders to enter into the Credit Agreement and make such financial accommodations, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Obligors and Collateral Agent have entered into an Amended and Restated Security Agreement dated as of October 1, 2010 (the “**Security Agreement**”) pursuant to which each Obligor has agreed to grant a security interest in the Collateral as security for the Secured Obligations, for the benefit of the Collateral Agent on behalf of the Secured Parties.

Pursuant to the Security Agreement, the Obligors have agreed as a condition thereof to execute this Agreement for recording with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office and the United States Copyright Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, each Obligor agrees as follows:

SECTION 1. Grant of Security. To secure the payment of the Secured Obligations when due, each Obligor hereby grants to the Collateral Agent for the benefit of the Lenders a security interest in and to all of such Obligor’s right, title and interest in and to the following (the “**Intellectual Property Collateral**”):

- (i) the patents and patent applications set forth in Schedule A hereto together with all reissues, divisions, continuations, renewals, continuations-in-part, extensions and
