INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, by unanimous written consent of the the board of directors of Coapt Systems, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("*Coapt Systems*" or the "*Company*"), and with the consent of the shareholders of Coapt Systems, on July 1, 2010, Coapt Systems, in accordance with the assignment for benefit of creditors laws of the State of California, transferred ownership of all of its right, title and interest in and to certain designated assets to Coapt (Assignment for the Benefit of Creditors), LLC ("*Coapt LLC*"), a California limited liability company, and in so doing has also designated Coapt LLC to act as the assignee for the benefit of creditors of Coapt Systems (the "*General Assignment*");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the General Assignment Agreement between Coapt Systems and Coapt LLC, all of Coapt Systems' rights title and interest in and to certain designated assets have been assigned to Coapt LLC, including the Company's patents and patent applications and trademark and trademark applications;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Asset Purchase Agreement dated August 13, 2010 between Coapt LLC and the Assignee (as defined hereinafter), Coapt LLC hereby wishes to assign the Company's patent and patent applications and trademark and trademark applications to MicroAire Surgical Instruments LLC, a Delaware limited liability company located at 1641 Edlich Drive, Charlottesville, Virginia (the "*Assignee*");


WHEREAS, Coapt LLC and Assignee desire to memorialize the transfer of the Company's patents and patent applications and related rights to Assignee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN, Coapt LLC does hereby convey, assign, transfer, deliver and set over, unto said Assignee, its successors and assigns, for good and valuable consideration the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged (1) the entire worldwide right, title and interest in and to each and all Letters Patents in the United States and in all foreign countries including, without limitation corresponding Patent Cooperation Treaty patent applications and corresponding National patent applications and all inventions, improvements and discoveries disclosed in said Letters Patents and applications which were held by the Company, as well as all trademarks and trademark applications which were held by the Company, immediately prior to the consummation of the General Assignment, including without limitation those set forth in Schedule A hereto, and in and to all substitutions, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reexaminations, extensions, renewals and reissues (as applicable) thereof, including without limitation of generality, all rights of priority resulting from the filing of patent applications relating to any of the foregoing as well as any and all choses in action and any and all claims and demands, both at law and in equity, that Assignor has or may have for damages or profits accrued or to accrue on account of the infringement of any of said Letter Patents, patent applications, inventions, improvements and discoveries (or any provisional rights therein), as well as in any uses, renewals, prioritys or actions for infringement or the like arising in trademark, the same to be held and enjoyed by Assignee, its successors and assigns, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the Company or Coapt LLC if the assignment set forth in this Patent Assignment had not been made; (2) the full and complete right to file patent applications or trademark applications in the name of the Company or its designee or Coapt LLC, at the Assignee's, or its designee's election, on the aforesaid inventions, improvements, discoveries and applications in all countries of the world; and (3) the entire right, title and interest in and to any Trademark Registrations or Letters Patent which may issue thereon in the United States or in any country, and any renewals, revivals, reissues, reexaminations and extensions thereof, and any patents of confirmation, registration and importation of the same.

AND Coapt LLC hereby authorizes and requests the United States Patent and Trademark Office, and any Patent Office foreign to the United States, to issue said Trademarks or Letters Patent in accordance with this Agreement.

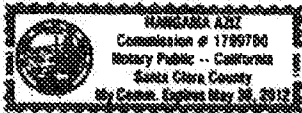

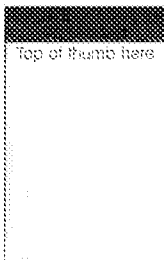
