

Description of the Collateral
Transferred to the Transferree
PICA: Pipeline Inspection and Condition Analysis Corporation

The Collateral transferred is described as:

1. Intellectual property related to Hydroscope technology:
 - A. U.S. Patent No. 5,675,251 and Canadian Patent App. 2,133,930. A method and apparatus for inspection of water distribution pipelines by various methods including remote field eddy current;
 - B. U.S. Patent No. 6,087,830 and Canadian Patent App. 2,245,419. A flexible device for remote field eddy current inspection of ferrous pipeline containing turns;
 - C. U.S. Patent No. 6,556,924 and Canadian Patent App. 2,354,191. A maintenance optimization system for water pipelines;
 - D. U.S. Patent No. 6,359,434 and Canadian Patent App. 2,249,092. A method and system for determining pipeline circumferential and noncircumferential wall loss defects in a water pipeline; and
 - E. U.S. trademark registration no. 2,239,398, for the mark "Hydroscope."
