**RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST
IN TRADEMARK COLLATERAL**

This RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN TRADEMARK COLLATERAL (this "Release"), dated as of December 15, 2010, is made by General Electric Capital Corporation (the "Administrative Agent"), in favor of Utex Industries, Inc. and DuraQuest, Inc. (each a "Grantor" and collectively, the "Grantors") as follows:

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Trademark Security Agreement, dated July 10, 2008 among the Administrative Agent and the Grantors party thereto (the "Security Agreement"), and recorded with The United States Patent and Trademark Office on July 16, 2008 at Reel/Frame No. 3816/0483, each of the Grantors granted the Administrative Agent for the benefit of the Secured Parties a security interest in and to all of its right, title and interest in the Trademark Collateral (as defined in the Security Agreement);

WHEREAS, the Administrative Agent acknowledges full payment, complete performance and satisfaction of all obligations pursuant to the Security Agreement have been made and that the requirements of Section 8.10(b)(iii) of the Credit Agreement have been met;

WHEREAS, the Grantors have requested that the Administrative Agent release its security interest in and to the Trademark Collateral.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Administrative Agent, without representation or warranty and at the Grantors' sole cost and expense, hereby (i) terminates the Security Agreement, and (ii) RELEASES, terminates and cancels all of its right, title and interest in and to the security interest granted to the Administrative Agent for the benefit of the Secured Parties pursuant to the Security Agreement in the Trademark Collateral, including, without limitation, each of the trademark registrations and applications set forth in Schedule A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

The Administrative Agent agrees to provide, at the Grantors' expense, the Grantors with all information and additional authorization and all cooperation and assistance (including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of all documents and other instruments) reasonably necessary to evidence and effect the termination and release of the Administrative Agent's security interest in the Trademark Collateral.
