

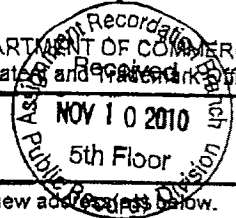

1. The levying officer is required to take custody of the property described in item 1 in your possession or under your control.

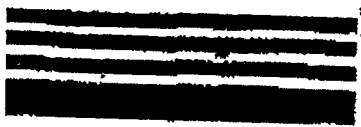


