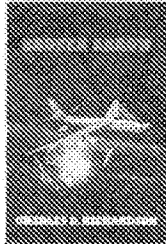

Daily Strategic Air Command training flights mimicked an assault on a Russian city or military complex using chest drops, air refueling, simulated bomb drops, simulated ground missile threats, and maritime fighter attacks. Col and cruise games were practiced with other military commands and with the Soviet Air Defense system at all hours.
