RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

This RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY (this "Release") is made as of May 25, 2011 by Comerica Bank, collateral agent and administrative agent ("Assignee"), in favor of Pentec Health, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation ("Borrower"), and each of the other signatories to the Collateral Assignment (as defined below) (collectively "Assignor").

WHEREAS, pursuant to (i) that certain Amended and Restated Financing Agreement dated as of March 30, 2010, among Borrower and Delaware Valley Home Care, Inc., as borrowers, each guarantor party thereto, each of the lenders from time to time party thereto (the "Lenders") and Assignee (the "Credit Agreement") and (ii) the Security Agreement, dated as of May 4, 2006 (as amended from time to time, the "Collateral Assignment"), Assignor granted and conveyed to Assignee a security interest in the registered trademarks, trade names, copyrights and domain names listed on Schedule A hereto (collectively, the "Intellectual Property");

WHEREAS, in connection with the termination of the Credit Agreement, Assignor has informed Assignee of its desire to obtain the release of Assignee's security interest in the Intellectual Property; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Credit Agreement and the Collateral Assignment, Assignee desires to release its security interest in the Intellectual Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignee hereby agrees as follows:

1. Assignee hereby waives, releases, relinquishes and abandons any and all liens, security interests, and any and all claims of liens or security interests and any other claim of rights, title, interest or goodwill, of any kind or nature whatsoever, in and to the Intellectual Property.
2. Assignee hereby agrees to duly execute, acknowledge, procure and deliver any further documents and to do such other acts as may be reasonably necessary to effect the release of the security interest contemplated hereby provided that Borrower reimburses Assignee (and Borrower hereby agrees to reimburse Assignee on demand) for all costs and expenses, including without limitation all fees and expenses of counsel, incurred in connection therewith. All releases, terminations and other documents delivered or authorized by Assignee or any Lenders pursuant to this Release shall be delivered without any representation, recourse or warranty whatsoever.
3. This Release shall be binding upon Assignee and its successors and assigns.
4. This Release may be executed by each party hereto on a separate counterpart, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original, but all of which together shall constitute one agreement. Delivery of an executed counterpart of this Release by telefacsimile or via e-mail in "PDF" format shall be equally as effective as delivery of an original executed counterpart of this Release.


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5. This Release shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of New York without regard to conflicts of laws principles.
