RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

THIS RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ("Release") is made effective as of July 21, 2011 by CITIBANK, N.A, as Agent (the "Agent") for the Secured Parties (as defined in the Credit Agreement), to BOOZ & COMPANY, INC., a Delaware corporation (the "Company") and BOOZ & COMPANY (N.A.) Inc., a Delaware corporation ("BCUS" and, collectively with the Company, the "Grantors"), as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, as the Grantors have satisfied (or otherwise made arrangements for) their obligations secured by the Intellectual Property pursuant to the Security Agreement, the Agent hereby releases, at the Grantors' sole cost and expense, all right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property, including its security interest in and lien upon the Intellectual Property.
