## FULL RELEASE AND RECONVEYANCE

THIS FULL RELEASE AND RECONVEYANCE (this "Agreement"), dated as of September 8, 2011, is granted by VENTURE LENDING & LEASING V, INC. ("VLL5") and VENTURE LENDING & LEASING VI, INC. ("VLL6"), both Maryland corporations (together as the "Secured Party"), in favor of YAP INC., a Delaware corporation ("Grantor").

### RECITALS

A. Reference is made to (i) that certain Loan and Security Agreement dated September 24, 2010 between Grantor, as borrower, and VLL5, as lender, and (ii) that certain Loan and Security Agreement date September 24, 2010 between Grantor, as borrower, and VLL6, as lender, as such agreements may from time to time be amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified (individually and together, the "Loan Agreement"). Grantor executed in favor of Secured Party the Loan Agreement granting a security interest in all Collateral and executed that certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement with respect to certain Intellectual Property. All capitalized terms used herein shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Loan Agreement and Intellectual Property Security Agreement.

B. Pursuant to that certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated September 24, 2010, by and between Grantor and Secured Party, Grantor granted to Secured Party a security interest in, among other things, (i) all now and hereafter acquired copyrights, including without limitation those set forth on Exhibit A (collectively, the "Copyrights"), (ii) all now and hereafter acquired trademarks, including without limitation those set forth on Exhibit B (collectively, the "Trademarks") and (iii) all now and hereafter acquired patents, including without limitation those set forth on Exhibit C (collectively, the "Patents")

C. Secured Party acted to perfect its security interest in the Patents, Copyrights and Trademarks by filing the Intellectual Property Security Agreement in the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("USPTO"), recorded on December 21, 2010 (the "Grant of Security Interest").

D. Secured Party has agreed to release its security interest in Grantor's Intellectual Property, including the Copyrights set forth on Exhibit A, the Trademarks set forth on Exhibit B and the Patents set forth on Exhibit C.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual promises and covenants, Secured Party hereby agrees as follows:

1. Secured Party hereby releases its security interest in Grantor's Intellectual Property granted pursuant to the Intellectual Property Security Agreement, including the Copyrights identified on Exhibit A, the Trademarks identified on Exhibit B, the Patents identified on Exhibit C, and all goodwill and common law rights associated therewith, unconditionally and irrevocably terminates the Grant of Security Interest recorded in the USPTO, including any right to assignment or license of the Copyrights set forth on Exhibit A, the Trademarks set forth on Exhibit B and the Patents set forth on Exhibit C, and hereby assigns to Grantor all of Secured Party's rights to and interest in the Copyrights, Trademarks and Patents.



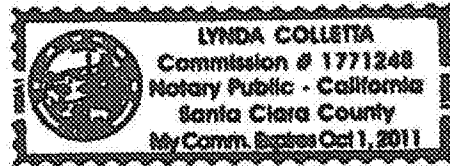
