TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

This TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT (this "Assignment"), dated as of July 31, 2009 (the "Effective Date") is between Voltarc Technologies, Inc., a Delaware corporation located at 400 Captain Neville Dr., Waterbury, CT ("Assignor") and LCD Lighting, Inc., a Connecticut corporation located at 37 Robinson Blvd., Orange, CT ("Assignee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of certain trademarks and tradenames, including without limitations those described on Schedule A attached hereto (the "Trademarks"); and

WHEREAS, for good and valuable consideration and pursuant to that certain Agreement of Purchase and Sale of Assets, dated July, 2009, by and between Assignor and Assignee (the "Purchase Agreement"), and upon the terms and conditions set forth below, Assignor desires to assign all of its rights, title, and interest with respect to the Trademarks to Assignee and Assignee desires to accept such assignment and all rights of Assignor associated with the Trademarks.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the transactions contemplated by the Purchase Agreement and this Assignment and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Assignment. Assignor hereby assigns and transfers unto Assignee, its successors, heirs and assigns all right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks, including without limitation, the right to any registrations thereof, the right to prosecute any applications therefor, the right to have any registrations issue in the name of the Assignee, the right to apply for and obtain any renewal of any registrations thereof, the right to any priorities based on the filing of the aforesaid applications, the right to sue for past and future infringement and the right to the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby.

2. Further Assurances. In the event the Assignee is unable for any reason to promptly secure Assignor's signature to any document required to effect the full intent of this Assignment and recordal of same with the appropriate agencies and offices, Assignor hereby irrevocably designates and appoints Assignee and its duly authorized officers and agents as its agents and attorneys-in-fact to act for and on Assignor's behalf and instead of Assignor, to execute such documents and to do all other lawfully permitted acts to further the intent of this Assignment and Assignee's ownership of the intellectual property rights granted herein with the same legal force and effect as if executed by Assignor.

3. Binding Provisions. This Assignment is binding upon, and inures to the benefit of, the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, legal representatives, successors, and permitted assigns.


4. Governing Law. All questions concerning the construction, validity and interpretation of this Assignment and the performance of the obligations imposed by this Assignment shall be governed by the internal law, not the law of conflicts, of the State of Connecticut.


