**PATENT AND TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT**

This Patent and Trademark Assignment Agreement (the "Assignment") is made and entered into as of June 8, 2012 between **OK-1 MANUFACTURING COMPANY**, an Oklahoma corporation (the "Assignor") and **OCCUNOMIX INTERNATIONAL LLC**, a Delaware limited liability company ("Assignee"). Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to such terms in the Agreement (as defined below).

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, contemporaneously herewith the parties have entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement, dated June 8, 2012 (the "Purchase Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Assignor is the sole owner of the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the (i) patents and patent applications, together with all related intellectual property rights relating thereto (collectively, the "Patents") described in Schedule A hereto, and (ii) trademarks and trademark applications, together with all related intellectual property rights relating thereto (collectively, the "Trademarks") described in Schedule B hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing Recitals and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignment of Patents and Trademarks. Assignor hereby represents and warrants that it is the sole owner of the Patents and Trademarks, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances, and it hereby sells, assigns, transfers, conveys, and delivers to Assignee its entire right, title and interest in and to the Patents and Trademarks, together with all rights, licenses and other agreements heretofore made by Assignor in respect of, or relating to, the Patents and Trademarks, and all income, royalties, fees and payments now or hereafter due or payable in respect to the Patents and Trademarks, including any rights to file an action and recover damages by reason of past infringement, misappropriation or other unauthorized use of the Patents or Trademarks, with a right to sue for, and collect the same for its own use and behalf, and for the use and behalf of its successors, assigns, or other legal representatives. Assignee hereby accepts Assignor's assignment and transfer of the Patents and Trademarks.

2. Further Assurances. Assignor shall execute, acknowledge and deliver to Assignee all documents, instruments and agreements as may be necessary to make a record with any governmental authority (both foreign and domestic) or third parties of this Assignment and Assignee's ownership of all right, title and interest in, to and under the Patents and Trademarks.

3. Patent and Trademark Office. Assignor hereby requests the Commissioner of Patents of the United States Patent and Trademark Office (the "Commissioner") record this Patent assignment to Assignee. Assignor hereby further requests the Commissioner to issue any and all letters patent of the United States or derived from the Patent to Assignee as assignee of the entire interest. Assignor hereby covenants that the Commissioner has full right to convey the

entire interest herein assigned, and that Assignor has not executed, and will not execute, any agreements inconsistent herewith.

4. Section Headings. The section headings contained herein are for reference purposes only and will not affect in any way the meaning or interpretation of this Assignment.

5. Governing Law. This Assignment will be governed by, and construed and enforced in accordance with, the laws of the State of New York, without giving effect to the conflict of laws principles thereof.

6. Agreement Controls. The provisions of this Assignment are subject to the terms and conditions of the Agreement. To the extent that any provision of this Assignment is inconsistent with the Agreement, the provisions of the Agreement will control.

7. Counterparts. This Assignment may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original, but which shall represent a single agreement.

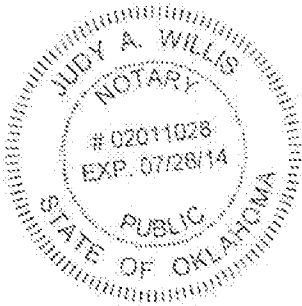
