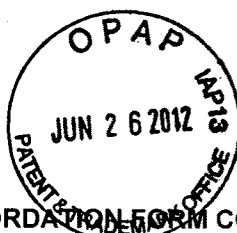

THIS DEED OF ASSIGNMENT is made the 4 day of JANUARY 2012

BETWEEN:

- (1) **STEAMFAST EUROPE LIMITED** incorporated and registered in England and Wales with company number 05273699 whose registered office is at Croft Cottage, Stevensons Lane, Hampton, Cheshire, England SY14 8JT (Assignor); and
- (2) **EXCELSIOR TECHNOLOGIES LIMITED** incorporated and registered in England and Wales with company number 05188170 whose registered office is at Unit 22-23, Parkway Deeside Industrial Park, Deeside, Flintshire, Clwyd, Wales CH5 2NS (Assignee).

WHEREAS

- (A) The Assignor is the registered proprietor of the applications for, and registrations of, certain intellectual property rights held on trust for the Assignee.
- (B) The Assignee is the beneficial owner of the applications for, and registrations of, certain intellectual property rights.
- (C) In accordance with the arrangement between the parties, the Assignor has agreed to assign to the Assignee all such intellectual property rights to the Assignee by way of confirmatory assignment on the terms set out below.

IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL OBLIGATIONS CONTAINED HEREIN NOW IT IS AGREED:

1. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

1.1 In this Agreement the following words and expressions have the following meanings unless the context otherwise requires:

- "Agreement" this deed of assignment including its Schedule;
- "Intellectual Property Rights" Any and all intellectual property rights including patents, rights to inventions, copyright and related rights, trade marks, trade names and domain names, rights in get-up, rights in goodwill or to sue for passing off, unfair competition rights, rights in designs, rights in computer software, database rights, rights in confidential information (including know-how and trade secrets) and any and all other intellectual property rights, in each case whether registered or unregistered and including all applications (and rights to apply) for, and renewals or extensions of, such rights and all similar or equivalent rights or forms of protection which subsist or will subsist, now or in the future, in any part of the world.
- Patents the patents and patent applications, short particulars of which are set out in Schedule 1
- Trade Marks The trade mark registrations and trade mark applications, short

particulars of which are set out in Schedule 2

Unregistered IPR any and all goodwill and other unregistered Intellectual Property Rights subsisting in the names and logos which are the subject of the Trade Marks (including the abandoned trade mark registrations and applications listed in Schedule 2) and any unregistered Intellectual Property Rights subsisting in the know how and inventions which are the subject of the Patents

- 1.2 In this Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires, any reference to:
 - 1.2.1 a "Schedule" shall be construed as a schedule to this Agreement;
 - 1.2.2 a "party" shall be construed as a signatory of this Agreement;
 - 1.2.3 the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and words denoting any gender shall include all genders;
 - 1.2.4 where the words "include(s)", "including" or "in particular" are used in this Agreement, they are deemed to have the words "without limitation" following them.
- 1.3 The Schedule forms part of and is deemed incorporated into this Agreement.
- 1.4 Clause headings are for ease of reference only and shall not affect the interpretation of this Agreement.
2. **ASSIGNMENT**
 - 2.1 In consideration of the sum of £1, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged by the Assignee, and in consideration of the mutual obligations herein, the Assignor with full title guarantee hereby irrevocably assigns to the Assignee the Trade Marks, the Patents and the Unregistered IPR (together the "Assigned IPR") together with:
 - 2.1.1 all renewals thereof and extensions thereto; and
 - 2.1.2 any and all statutory and common law rights now or hereafter relating to the Assigned IPR including without limitation the right to file for registration and the right to sue for damages and other remedies in respect of any infringements existing at or occurring prior to the date of this Agreement.
3. **PROCEEDINGS**
 - 3.1 The Assignor agrees and undertakes to provide to the Assignee (at the Assignee's request and at the Assignor's cost) all reasonable assistance with any proceedings which may be brought against the Assignee by any third party relating to the rights assigned by this Agreement.
 - 3.2 The Assignor agrees and undertakes to provide to the Assignee (at the Assignee's request and cost) all reasonable assistance with any proceedings which may be brought by the Assignee against any third party relating to the rights assigned by this Agreement.

4. **WARRANTIES**

The Assignor hereby represents, warrants and undertakes in favour of the Assignee that:

- 4.1 the Assigned IPR are vested in it absolutely and that it has not previously assigned, licensed, granted to any third party or in any way encumbered such rights so as to derogate from the assignment hereby made;
- 4.2 it is not aware of any claims (actual or threatened) that use of the Assigned IPR will infringe the Intellectual Property Rights of any third party;
- 4.3 it is not aware of any claims (actual or threatened) that the Trade Marks or Patents are invalid or could be revoked;
- 4.4 it has good title and full right and authority to enter into this Agreement and assign the Assigned IPR as herein provided; and
- 4.5 the Trade Marks and Patents which have proceeded to grant have been maintained and are in force, and all renewal fees have been paid.

5. **INDEMNITY**

- 5.1 The Assignor shall indemnify and keep the Assignee indemnified against any action, claim, demand, costs, charges and expenses incurred by the Assignee by reason of any breach or alleged breach of the warranties given in this Agreement including (but not limited to) all costs and damages which the Assignee may incur or become liable for in defending any claim (of which the Assignor was aware as at the date of this Agreement) by a third party that use of the Assigned IPR infringes the rights of that party or that a third party owns any right or interest in the Assigned IPR.

6. **FURTHER ASSURANCE**

- 6.1 The Assignor shall do or procure to be done at its own cost all such further acts and things, and execute or procure the execution of all such other documents, as the Assignee may from time to time reasonably require in order to give the Assignee the full benefit of the rights purported to be granted under this Agreement, whether in connection with any registration of title or other similar right or otherwise and to record at the relevant registries the change in ownership of the Trade Marks and the Patents.
- 6.2 The Assignor hereby irrevocably appoints the Assignee as its lawful attorney in its name and on its behalf to do such acts or execute all and any deeds, documents and instruments to give effect to the intent of this assignment or do anything as may be required by the Assignee to enable the Assignee to enjoy the full benefit of the rights confirmed and assigned by this Agreement. The Assignor declares that all and anything which shall be done by the attorney in relation to or in connection with the above shall be as good, valid and effective to all intents and purposes whatsoever as if the same had been done by the Assignor. The Assignor undertakes to ratify and confirm whatsoever the attorney shall lawfully cause to be done pursuant to the power of attorney.

7. RECORDS

- 7.1 Within 14 days of the date of this Assignment the Assignor shall provide the Assignee with all documents and records relating to the Assigned IPR, including copies of any correspondence with the Assignor's trade mark agents, patent attorneys and any relevant registries.

8. WAIVER OF MORAL RIGHTS

- 8.1 The Assignor hereby agrees to procure the irrevocable and unconditional waiver of any and all moral rights which subsist in the Assigned IPR by virtue of Chapter 4 of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 including the right to be identified as the creator of the copyright protected works granted by section 77 and the right to object to derogatory treatment thereof granted by section 80 of that Act and, so far as is legally possible, any broadly equivalent rights in the Assigned IPR in any territory of the world.

9. GENERAL

- 9.1 No failure to exercise and no delay in exercising, on the part of either of the parties, any right or remedy in respect of any provision of this Agreement shall operate as a waiver of that right or remedy and any single or partial exercise of any right or remedy shall not preclude any other or further exercise of that right or remedy.
- 9.2 This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts each of which when taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement.
- 9.3 No waiver by either party of a breach or a default hereunder shall be effective unless in writing and signed by both parties and any such waiver shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any subsequent breach or default of the same or similar nature.
- 9.4 No amendment of the terms of this assignment shall be valid or binding unless made by prior written agreement between the parties. To the extent permitted by law all provisions of this assignment shall be severable and no provision shall be affected by the invalidity or unenforceability of any other provision.

10. LAW AND JURISDICTION

- 10.1 This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England. The parties hereby irrevocably submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts in respect of any dispute or matter arising out of or in connection with this Agreement.

11. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

- 11.1 This Agreement, together with any document expressly referred to in any of its terms, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties relating to the subject matter covered and supersedes all previous agreements, arrangements, undertakings or proposals or representations, written or oral, in relation to such matters.
- 11.2 The parties confirm that, in agreeing to enter into this Agreement, they have not relied on any representation save insofar as the same has expressly been made in this Agreement and agree

that they shall have no remedy in respect of any misrepresentation which has not become a term of this Agreement save that the agreement of the parties contained in this clause shall not apply in respect of any fraudulent or negligent misrepresentation whether or not such has become a term of this Agreement.


