

### ARTICLE 1 Name

# ARTICLE 7 Indemnification

The right to and the amount of indemnification will be determined in accordance with the provisions of the Act in effect at the time of the determination.

To the fullest extent permitted by the Act, this Company must pay for or reimburse any and all reasonable expenses incurred by a member, manager or fiduciary of this Company who is a party to a proceeding in advance of the final disposition of the proceeding.

For purposes of determining the right to any indemnification under this Article, the termination of any action, suit or proceeding by judgment, order, settlement, conviction or upon a plea of nolo contendre, or its equivalent, shall not, of itself, create a presumption that: (i) a member, manager or fiduciary breached his/her/its duty of loyalty to this Company or its members; (ii) a member, manager or fiduciary acted or failed to act in good faith, which action or inaction involved intentional misconduct or knowing violation of law; or (iii) a member, manager or fiduciary derived improper personal benefit from a transaction.

The right to indemnification and to the payment or reimbursement of expenses with regard to a proceeding referred to in this Article is not exclusive of any other rights to which any person may be entitled or hereafter acquire under any statute, provision of the Articles of Organization, Operating Agreement, vote by the managers, vote by the members, or otherwise, and will continue as to any person who has ceased to be a member, manager or
