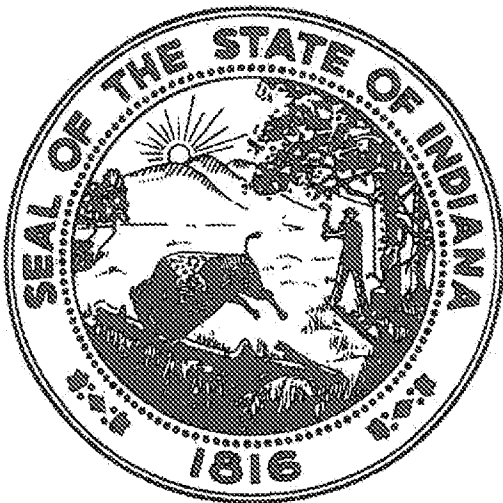



AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS
OF
ROLL COATER, INC.
ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
ON OCTOBER 21, 2011

AMENDMENT NO. 1:

Effective upon the filing of the Articles of Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation of Roll Coater, Inc. (the "Corporation") with the Indiana Secretary of State, all references to "Roll Coater, Inc." in the bylaws of the Corporation shall be changed to "Precoat Metals Corp."

AMENDMENT NO. 2:

Article IV (Board of Directors) shall be amended to add in a new Section 12 to read as follows:

Section 12 - Indemnification. In accordance with the Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall indemnify and upon request advance expenses to every person who is or was a party or is or was threatened to be made a party to any action, suit, or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, by reason of the fact that he/she is or was a director or officer of the corporation or, while a director or officer or employee of the corporation, is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a director, officer, employee, agent or trustee of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, employee benefit plan or other enterprise, against expenses (including counsel fees), judgments, fines and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by him/her in connection with such action, suit or proceeding, to the full extent permitted by applicable law.
