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## TRADEMARK SECURITY INTEREST RELEASE

THIS TRADEMARK SECURITY INTEREST RELEASE (this “Release”) made as of October 26, 2012 by THE TORONTO-DOMINION BANK (the “Administrative Agent”) in favor of Q9 Networks Inc., an Ontario corporation (“Registrant”).

### RECITALS:

A. Reference is hereby made to that certain Loan Agreement dated as of October 24, 2008 (as amended, restated, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the “Loan Agreement”) by and among CDC Acquisition III Corp., an Ontario corporation (“CDC”), as the “Borrower”, CDC Acquisition II Corp. as the “Parent”, the lenders signatory thereto (the “Lenders”) and the Administrative Agent, as administrative agent for and on behalf of the Lenders and (ii) that certain Payoff Letter, dated as of October 16, 2012 by and among Registrant (as successor by amalgamation to CDC) and the Administrative Agent.

B. Pursuant to an amalgamation on October 24, 2008, under the Ontario, Canada, Business Corporations Act between Registrant and CDC, the trademarks of Registrant listed below became subject to a continuing security interest and lien in favor of the Administrative Agent for its own benefit and the benefit of the other Lenders pursuant to a certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated October 24, 2008 (the “Agreement”), by and among CDC, in its capacity as “Grantor” and the Administrative Agent, as “Grantee”, and other related financing documents:


