ASSIGNMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

This Assignment of Intellectual Property Rights Agreement (Agreement) is entered into this 4th day of March, 2013 (Effective Date) by and between The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), a former independent agency of the Government and current component of the United States Department of Homeland Security having a place of business at 500 C Street, SW, Washington DC 20472 (Assignor), and The United States Department of Homeland Security, a federal agency having its principal place of business at 245 Murray Lane, SW Washington DC 20528 (Assignee).

- A. WHEREAS, the Assignee, prior to March 1, 2003, was an independent agency of the United States Government, and on January 28, 2002 filed an application for registration of trademark with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) for the standard character word mark CITIZEN CORPS (the Mark);
- B. WHEREAS, Assignor became a component of the United States Department of Homeland Security effective March 1, 2003, pursuant to the Homeland Security Act of 2002, legislation enacted following the September 11 2001 attacks to combine and empower one cabinet department of the United States Government with the primary responsibilities of protecting the United States from and responding to terrorist attacks, man-made accidents, and natural disasters;
- C. WHEREAS, Assignor's application for registration of the Mark matured to registration on August 30, 2005 with Registration No. 2988453 for

services in: (i) International Class 035 for “rendering management and technical assistance relating to emergency response efforts to terrorist attacks and incidents involving national security and national defense, and promoting the public awareness of opportunities for volunteer service and for public service”; (ii) International Class 041 for “educational services, namely conducting workshops, seminars, and training, for volunteer service, public service, and emergency preparedness programs”; and (iii) International Class 042 for “providing technical consultation to local governments and to police departments, fire departments and emergency medical services departments in the field of emergency preparedness and emergency response procedures in connection with incidents involving national defense and national security, and providing information in the fields of volunteer service and of public service opportunities via the internet”;

- D. WHEREAS, Assignee in September 2008, through its Office of the General Counsel, established an Intellectual Property Law division to develop department-wide processes for intellectual property created or owned by Assignee, including Assignee’s components, one of which is Assignor;
- E. WHEREAS, Assignee implemented policies that required all new trademark applications to be processed through the Office of the General Counsel and all registered trademarks and pending trademark applications

to be transitioned to a DHS trademark portfolio administered by the Office of the General Counsel;

F. WHEREAS, Assignor is listed in USPTO records as the owner of the registration of the Mark and desires to transition management of the Mark to the Office of the General Counsel in compliance with department policy;

E. WHEREAS, Assignor desires to relinquish all rights, title and interest in such Mark to Assignee and Assignee desires to acquire all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to Mark, together with all goodwill symbolized by the Mark.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by Assignor, the parties agree as follows:

A. Assignor hereby conveys and assigns to Assignee, and Assignee hereby accepts from Assignor, all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Mark, together with the goodwill symbolized by the Mark.

B. Assignor represents and warrants that:

(1) Assignor owns the entire right, title and interest in and to the Mark; and

(2) Assignor has all authority necessary to enter into this Agreement and the execution and delivery of this Agreement has been duly and validly authorized.
