ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

OM Financial Life Insurance Company, a Maryland corporation (the "Corporation"), hereby certifies to the State Department of Assessments and Taxation that:

FIRST: The charter of the Corporation is hereby amended by deleting existing Article Second in its entirety and adding a new article to read as follows:

"SECOND: The name of the Corporation is: Fidelity & Guaranty Life Insurance Company."

SECOND: The amendment to the charter of the Corporation as set forth above has been approved by a majority of the entire Board of Directors and the amendment is limited to a change expressly authorized by Section 2-605(a)(1) of the Corporations & Associations Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, to be made without action by the stockholder.

THIRD: The amendment to the charter of the Corporation as set forth above shall become effective on the later of: (i) the date the State Department of Assessments and Taxation accepts the amendment for record; or (ii) immediately after closing occurring pursuant to a First Amended and Restated Stock Purchase Agreement dated February 17, 2011 between OM Group (UK) Limited and Harbinger OM, LLC, but no later than 30 days after the amendment is accepted for record by the State Department of Assessment and Taxation.

FOURTH: The undersigned General Counsel and Senior Vice President acknowledges these Articles of Amendment to be the corporate act of the Corporation and as to all matters or facts required to be verified under oath, the undersigned General Counsel and Senior Vice President acknowledges that to the best of his knowledge, information and belief, these matters and facts are true in all material respects and that this statement is made under the penalties for perjury.



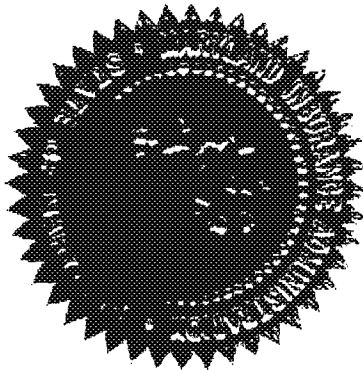
