WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of that certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement (the “2010 Security Agreement”, together with the 2007 Security Agreement, the “Security Agreement”), dated as of April 21, 2010 by and between the Borrower and the Lender as filed with the Assignment Division at the United States Patent and Trademark Office on April 23, 2010 at Reel 004191, Frame 00231, the Borrower granted to the Lender a security interest in and lien on all of its Trademark Collateral (as defined in the 2010 Security Agreement), all of its Patent Collateral (as defined in the 2010 Security Agreement), and all of its Copyright Collateral (as defined in the 2010 Security Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the Lender wishes to release the security interest in and lien on the all of the Trademark Collateral, including, without limitation, the trademarks identified on Schedule A, attached hereto, all of the Patent Collateral, including, without limitation, the patents identified on Schedule B attached hereto, and all of the Copyright Collateral, including, without limitation, the copyrights identified on Schedule C attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Lender states as follows:

The Lender hereby terminates and releases its security interest in and first priority lien on the Trademark Collateral, the Patent Collateral and the Copyright Collateral, and the Lender hereby assigns and transfers to the Borrower, without recourse, all of its right, title and interest in and to the Trademark Collateral, the Patent Collateral and the Copyright Collateral, including, without limitation, each of the trademarks identified on Schedule A attached hereto, each of the patents identified on Schedule B attached hereto, and each of the copyrights identified on Schedule C attached hereto, effective as of the date set forth above.
