CONFIRMATORY TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

This Trademark Assignment ("Assignment") is made this 1 day of October, 2013, by and among the American Pharmacists Association ("APhA"), a District of Columbia non-profit corporation with a principal place of business at 2215 Constitution Avenue, N.W., Washington D.C. 20037-2985, The American Pharmacists Association Foundation ("APhAF") (APhA and APhAF are jointly referred to as "Assignees") and the National Alliance of State Pharmacy Associations ("NASPA" or "Assignor"), collectively "the Parties."

Agreement

Thus, the Assignor and Assignees are joint owners of the Trademarks. The Trademarks include, but are not limited to, the following trademark registration:
