## TRADEMARK SECURITY INTEREST RELEASE

This **TRADEMARK SECURITY INTEREST RELEASE** (this "Release") is made as of November 11, 2013 (the "Release Date") in favor of CALIFORNIA PRODUCTS CORPORATION (the "Borrower") and FIBERLOCK TECHNOLOGIES, INC. (together with the Borrower, the "Grantors") by FIRSTLIGHT FINANCIAL CORPORATION, as administrative agent (in such capacity, the "Administrative Agent") pursuant to that certain Revolving Credit and Term Loan Agreement dated as of November 2, 2007 (the "Credit Agreement") by and among the Borrower, CPC Holding LLC (the "Parent"), the Administrative Agent, Bank of America, N.A., as documentation agent, Bank of Montreal, as syndication agent, and the Lenders a party thereto. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to such terms in the Credit Agreement or the Security Agreement (as defined below), as applicable.

**WHEREAS**, the Grantors and the Parent are a party to that certain Security Agreement, dated as of November 2, 2007 (the "Security Agreement") in favor of the Administrative Agent;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Security Agreement, the Grantors and the Parent collaterally assigned, conveyed, mortgaged, pledged, hypothecated and transferred to the Administrative Agent for the benefit of the Secured Parties and granted to the Administrative Agent for the benefit of the Secured Parties a lien on and security interest in all of their rights, titles and interests in, to and under certain intellectual property;

**WHEREAS**, the Grantors, in connection with the Security Agreement, entered into that certain Trademark Collateral Agreement, dated as of August 24, 2009 (the "Trademark Collateral Agreement") for the purpose of recording such security interest with respect to the Trademarks and the Trademark Licenses of the Grantors, including those items set forth on Schedule A (the "Trademark Collateral") hereto with the United States Patent and Trademark Office;

**WHEREAS**, the Trademark Collateral Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on November 4, 2009 at Reel 004090, Frame 0644;

**WHEREAS**, the Grantors have paid all of their outstanding indebtedness to the Agent.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Administrative Agent, on behalf of itself and the Secured Parties, hereby (i) acknowledges and confirms the full and complete satisfaction of Grantors' indebtedness under the Security Agreement with respect to the Trademark Collateral; (ii) terminates the Trademark Collateral Agreement, (iii) terminates, cancels, waives, relinquishes, abandons and releases any and all rights, obligations, liens, or security interests, and any and all claims of liens or security

interests, of any kind or nature, in and to any of the Trademark Collateral; (iv) authorizes and directs the U.S. Patent & Trademark Office to release the security interests; and (v) re-assigns to the Grantors any right, title and interest it may have in, to and under the Trademark Collateral to the Grantors.

The Administrative Agent shall, at the Grantors' expense, take all further actions, and provide to the Grantors, their successors, assigns or other legal representatives, all such cooperation and assistance (including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of any and all documents or other instruments), reasonably requested by the Grantors to more fully and effectively effectuate the purposes of this Release.
