RELEASE OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY INTEREST

DECEMBER 17, 2013

This RELEASE OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY INTEREST (this "Release") is made and effective as of December 17, 2013 and granted by SILICON VALLEY BANK (the "Bank"), a California corporation, located at One Newton Executive Park, 2221 Washington Street, Suite 2000, Newton, Massachusetts 02462, as Bank for the Secured Parties (as defined in the Loan Agreement referred to below), in favor of FIBERLINK COMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation located at 1787 Sentry Parkway West, Building Eighteen, Suite 200, Blue Bell, Pennsylvania 19422 (the "Grantor").

WHEREAS, Grantor entered into a Loan Agreement dated as of June 8, 2010 (the "Loan Agreement") with the Bank; capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the Loan Agreement;

WHEREAS, in connection with the Loan Agreement, Grantor executed and delivered to the Bank that certain Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated as of June 8, 2010, made by and among the Grantor and the Bank, in favor of the Bank (the "Intellectual Property Security Agreement");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Intellectual Property Security Agreement, Grantor pledged and granted to the Bank a security interest in all of Grantor's right, title and interest, whether presently existing or hereafter acquired, in, to and under the Intellectual Property Collateral (as defined below);

WHEREAS, the Intellectual Property Security Agreement was recorded at (i) the United States Patent and Trademark Office at Reel 025833/Frame 0509 on February 23, 2011, (ii) the United States Trademark Office at Reel 4484/Frame 0396 on February 23, 2011 and (iii) the United States Copyright Office at Volume 3591/Document 265 on June 16, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Grantor has requested that the Bank enter into this Release in order to accomplish and evidence the release and reassignment of any and all right, title and interest that the Bank may have in the Intellectual Property Collateral pursuant to the Intellectual Property Security Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Bank hereby states as follows:

SECTION 1. Definitions. The term "Intellectual Property Collateral", as used herein, shall mean all of the Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under its intellectual property, including, without limitation, the following:

(a) any and all copyright rights, copyright applications and registrations and like protections in each work of authorship and derivative work thereof, whether published or unpublished and whether or not the same also constitutes a trade secret, now or hereafter

existing, created, acquired or held including without limitation those set forth in Exhibit A hereto (collectively, the "Copyrights");

(b) any and all trade secrets, and any and all intellectual property rights in computer software and computer software products now or hereafter existing, created, acquired or held;

(c) any and all design rights that may be available to Grantor now or hereafter existing, created, acquired or held;

(d) all patents, patent applications and similar protections including, without limitation, improvements, divisions, continuations, renewals, reissues, extensions and continuations-in-part of the same, including without limitation the patents and patent applications set forth in Exhibit B hereto (collectively, the "Patents");

(e) any trademark and service mark rights, whether registered or not, applications to register and registrations of the same and like protections, and the entire goodwill of the business of the Grantor connected with and symbolized by such trademarks, including without limitation those set forth in Exhibit C hereto (collectively, the "Trademarks");

(f) all mask works or similar rights available for the protection of semiconductor chips, now owned or hereafter acquired, including, without limitation, those set forth in Exhibit D hereto (collectively, the "Mask Works");

(g) any and all claims for damages by way of past, present and future infringements of any of the rights included above, with the right, but not the obligation, to sue for and collect such damages for said use or infringement of the intellectual property rights identified above;

(h) all licenses or other rights to use any of the Copyrights, Patents, Trademarks or Mask Works and all license fees and royalties arising from such use to the extent permitted by such license or rights;

(i) all amendments, extensions, renewals and extensions of any of the Copyrights, Trademarks, Patents, or Mask Works;

(j) all proceeds and products of the foregoing, including without limitation all payments under insurance or any indemnity or warranty payable in respect of any of the foregoing.

(k) **SECTION 2. Release of Security Interest.** The Bank, on behalf of itself and its successors, legal representatives and assigns, terminates, releases and discharges its security interest in and to the Intellectual Property Collateral, and all other right, title, and interest in and to the Intellectual Property Collateral and reassigns to the Grantor any and all such right, title and interest that it may have in the Intellectual Property Collateral.

SECTION 3. Further Assurances. The Bank agrees to execute, acknowledge, procure and deliver to Grantor any and all further documents or instruments and do any and all further acts which the Grantor (or its agents, designees or assignees) reasonably requests in order to confirm, effectuate or record this Release and Grantor's (or its assignees') right, title and interest


in and to the Intellectual Property Collateral, in each case at the expense of the Grantor (including attorneys' fees and expenses).

SECTION 4. Governing Law. This Release and any claim, controversy, dispute or cause of action (whether in contract or tort or otherwise) based upon, arising out of or relating to this Release and the transactions contemplated hereby and thereby shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the United States and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, without giving effect to any choice or conflict of law provision or rule (whether of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts or any other jurisdiction).
