

**STATEMENT OF ELECTION  
OF  
Cooperative for Assistance and Relief Everywhere, Inc.**

Pursuant to the provisions of the District of Columbia Nonprofit Corporation Act (DC Code Title 29, Chapter 3), the undersigned corporation elects to avail itself thereto:

- FIRST: The name of the corporation is the Cooperative for Assistance and Relief Everywhere, Inc.
- SECOND: A resolution recommending that the corporation accept the District of Columbia Nonprofit Corporation Act was adopted at a meeting of members held on December 2, 2009 at which a quorum was present, and the resolution received at least two-thirds of the votes that members present at such meeting were entitled to cast.
- THIRD: The purpose or purposes which the corporation will hereafter pursue are: (i) alleviating global poverty by assisting people in developing parts of the world and people affected by natural or other disasters; and (ii) educating the public about issues related to global poverty.
- FOURTH: The Corporation shall have voting members whose classes, qualifications, rights and privileges, shall be as set forth in the bylaws.
- SIXTH: The manner in which directors shall be elected or appointed shall be provided in the bylaws.
- SEVENTH: No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any director, employee or other individual, partnership, estate, trust or corporation having a personal or private interest in the corporation. Compensation for services actually rendered and reimbursement for expenses actually incurred in attending to the affairs of this Corporation shall be limited to reasonable amounts. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, its assets shall be disposed of exclusively for the purposes of the corporation or distributed to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for the promotion of social welfare or for charitable purposes which shall, at the time, qualify as exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.


