ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARKS AND SERVICE MARKS

This Agreement is entered into by and between Enviromotive, Inc., a California Corporation, having a principle place of business at 111 Colorado Court, Los Gatos, California 95032 (hereinafter "EMI") and MotorVac Technologies, Inc., a Delaware Corporation, having a principle place of business at 1431 S. Village Way, Santa Ana, California 92705 (hereinafter "MTI").

Whereas, the trademarks and service marks identified on Exhibit "B" attached hereto (hereinafter referred to as the "Trademarks" and "Service Marks"), were adopted and used by Parker Automotive Corporation;

Whereas, EMI acquired certain assets of Parker Automotive Corporation, including the Trademarks and Service Marks together with the goodwill of the business associated therewith from the Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Trustee of Parker Automotive Corporation pursuant to a certain Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of February 7, 1992;

Whereas, on or about August 28, 1992, EMI granted a license to use and the right to acquire the Trademarks and Service Marks together with the goodwill of the business associated therewith to CarbonClean Holdings International, Ltd., a Barbadian Corporation (hereinafter "CCHIL");

Whereas, on or about March 30, 1994, CCHIL was amalgamated under Barbados law into MotorVac International Marketing, Ltd., a Barbadian Corporation (hereinafter "MIML");


Whereas, on or about June 9, 1994, MIML became a wholly owned subsidiary of MTI;

Whereas, on or about November 29, 1995, MIML was dissolved (effective December 31, 1995) under the laws of Barbados, its assets being transferred as a matter of law to MTI; and

Whereas, the parties hereto desire that all rights, domestic and, to the extent such rights may exist, international, which EMI has in the Trademarks and Service Marks, together with any rights at common law arising therefrom, and together with any goodwill of the business associated therewith, be assigned to MTI;

Now, therefore, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, EMI does hereby assign to MTI, its successors and assigns, all rights domestic and, to the extent such rights exist, international which EMI has in the Trademarks and Service Marks, together with any rights at common law arising therefrom, any goodwill of the business associated therewith, and the right to sue and collect for past infringement.
